24:43:11:17. Transcription of postsecondary credits on a high school

transcript. Postsecondary course credit required to be recorded on a student's transcript in accordance with SDCL 13-28-37, shall be transcribed in the following manner:

- (1) The number of credits earned at the high school level shall be as follows:
 - (a) Three postsecondary credits equal one high school credit;
 - (b) Two postsecondary credits equal three-fourth a high school credits;
 - (c) One postsecondary credit equals one-half a high school credits;
 - (d) Zero postsecondary credit courses shall be noted on the transcript with zero credits awarded;
 - (e) Four or more postsecondary credits equal one and a quarter high school credits.
- (2) When a postsecondary course is aligned to a graduation requirement content area as identified in 24:43:11:02, the school district shall award credit as a graduation requirement. All other postsecondary credit shall be transcribed as elective credit.
