CONSTRUCTION PLAN REVIEW

Electronic Construction Plan Review


- Conducted 4-7 months in advance of Letting
- Collaborative Review involving multiple Offices
- Conducted via Bluebeam (web-based real-time)



- Review Comments addressed by the Project Manager and Design Team
- Final Plan Submittal to Bid Letting

Includes submittal of all necessary clearance and certifications

Conduct Quality
 Assurance Review



Scheduling Projects for Letting

- Schedule Projects within the Bid Letting System approximately 3-4 months prior to the Bid Opening
- Publish and Maintain Anticipated Letting Schedule
- Factors
 - Final Plans Delivery
 - ROW/Utility/Airport/Railroad Certifications
 - Environmental Clearances
 - Coordination with other projects
- Balance lettings to achieve competitive bids
- Ramifications
 - Bid Prices
 - Completion Dates
 - Programming (future project scheduling)





STIP Estimate

- High Level Planning Estimate
- Based on scope of work
 - Often use average per mile costs
- Initially completed at time the project is scoped and programmed
- Updated annually as additional information is available

Engineers Estimate

- Detailed Estimate
- Based on final construction plans
 - Up to 300+ individual Bid Items with Quantities
- Completed approximately 2-3 months prior to the Bid Letting





PREQUALIFICATION STATUS

Prequalified is specified work type Prequalification has not expired

BIDDING CAPACTIY

Maximum bidding capacity – amount of outstanding work

Per contract amount

BID PROPOSAL GUARANTY

A security to guarantee the bidder will enter into contract if the bid is accepted.

Bid Bond - 5% of the total amount of the bid

Bid Analysis/ Post Bid Opening

Good Standing (Secretary of State, Motor Vehicles, Revenue)

DBE & GFE Documentation

Bid Analysis

- Compare Unit Prices (bid vs. estimate)
- Unbalanced Bids
- Justify Differences
- Identify Potential Revisions
- Learn Through Experiences





- Urgency of project
- Options for re-bidding
- Stakeholder Concurrence (City, County, FHWA)
- Justification for bids over estimate (10%+)
