Sarah Spader updated the council on the following: South Dakota remains well above the threshold of 80% for compliance in both parole and probation by being in the mid to high 90%s to 100%. Sarah has conducted new staff training in December 2024 and April 2025. Director Frieberg reported that both probation and parole compliance is still above national averages. Training for new probation staff covered both ICAOS policy and ICOTS processes.
