

South Dakota Board of Education Standards
Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held in the MacKay Building, First Floor, Library Commons, 800 Governors Drive, Pierre, SD on May 22, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. CT, to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed rules numbered

ARSD 24:43 (Dual Credit).

The effect of the rules will be to require all school districts to uniformly transcribe postsecondary credits onto a student's high school transcript.

The reason for adopting the proposed rules is to comply with SB 182 (13-28-37).

At the public hearing, the South Dakota Board of Education Standards will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rules. The board may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.
