24:43:11:17 Transcription of postsecondary credits on a high school transcript.

24:43:11:17. Transcription of postsecondary credits on a high school transcript. A school shall transcribe the number of high school credits a student earned in a postsecondary course on the student's transcript, in accordance with SDCL 13-28-37, in the following manner:

- (1) Three postsecondary credits equal one high school credit;
- (2) Two postsecondary credits equal three-fourths of a high school credit;
- (3) One postsecondary credit equals one-half of a high school credit;
- (4) A zero postsecondary credit course must be noted on a transcript with zero high school credit awarded; and
- (5) Four or more postsecondary credits equal one and one-fourth high school credits.

If a postsecondary course is aligned to a graduation requirement content area as identified in § 24:43:11:02, the school district must award credit as a graduation requirement. The school shall transcribe all other postsecondary credit as elective credit.
