SOUTH DAKOTA ONE CALL NOTIFICATION BOARD MEETING

April 16, 2020 – 1:00 PM Central Time (Noon Mountain Time)

- 1. Call to Order and Roll Call
 - a. Board Members Present: Chairman, Fay Jandreau, Representing Telecommunication Companies Offering Local Exchange Service to Less Than 50, 000 Customers; Vice Chairman, Doug Larson, Representing Interstate Carriers of Gas or Petroleum; Jim Scull, Representing Excavation Contractors; Dan Kaiser, Representing Telecommunication Companies Offering Local Exchange Service to More Than 50,000 Customers; Steve Mohr, Representing Community Antenna Television Systems; Bleau LaFave, Representing Investor-Owned Natural Gas Utilities; Kevin Kouba, Representing Investor-Owned Electric Utilities; Mark Meier, Representing Municipalities; Loren Beld, Representing Excavation Contractors. Brett Koenecke, Legal Counsel; Executive Director, Larry Janes; Deputy Director, Codi Gregg.

- 2. Mark Meier made the motion to approve the minutes as printed. Doug Larson seconded the motion. **Motion carried unanimously.**
- 3. The Board of Directors continued discussion on the best way to approach the potential for modifications to SDCL 49-7A Statutes and Article 20:25 of the Administrative Rules in response to COVID-19 concerns. The Board heard and discussed several options and possible scenarios of all potential solutions. In any offered solution, South Dakota One Call will work within limitations of state law, as well as with the Governor's Office to ensure utilities and excavators are protected.

Dan Kaiser made a motion to approach the Governor's Office now, in the event of workforce delays due to COVID-19, to the degree that SD811 laws cannot be upheld, including moving the locate clock to ninety-six hours in place of the forty-eight hours, as well as the Enforcement Panel suspending actions related to delayed locating. This motion failed after no second was received.

Further discussion was held on other possibilities and ramifications. The Board of Directors is in agreement that a proactive stance is where we want to be.

Dan Kaiser made an amended motion that the Board of Directors empower the Strategic Planning committee to monitor the conditions. If it is felt that action needs to be taken, the Strategic Planning Committee work with legal counsel and the Governor's Office to establish a best practice, within the confines of the laws governing One Call in order to add some flexibility to meet work force demands. Bleau LaFave seconded the motion. Upon further discussion, Kevin Kouba stated that language has already been proposed by legal counsel, all the Board needs to do in enact that language. The proposed verbiage allows South Dakota 811 to suspend the requirements as stated in SDCL49-7A once the Board feels it is time. The Board agreed.

Dan Kaiser again amended the motion, allowing a select group of representatives, namely: Fay Jandreau, Brett Koenecke, Larry Janes and Codi Gregg the authority to submit on the Board's behalf the proposed legislative changes allowing for flexibility in the timelines of SDCL 49-7A and Administrative Rules 20:25. Bleau LaFave seconded the amended amended motion. **Motion carried unanimously upon a roll call vote.**
