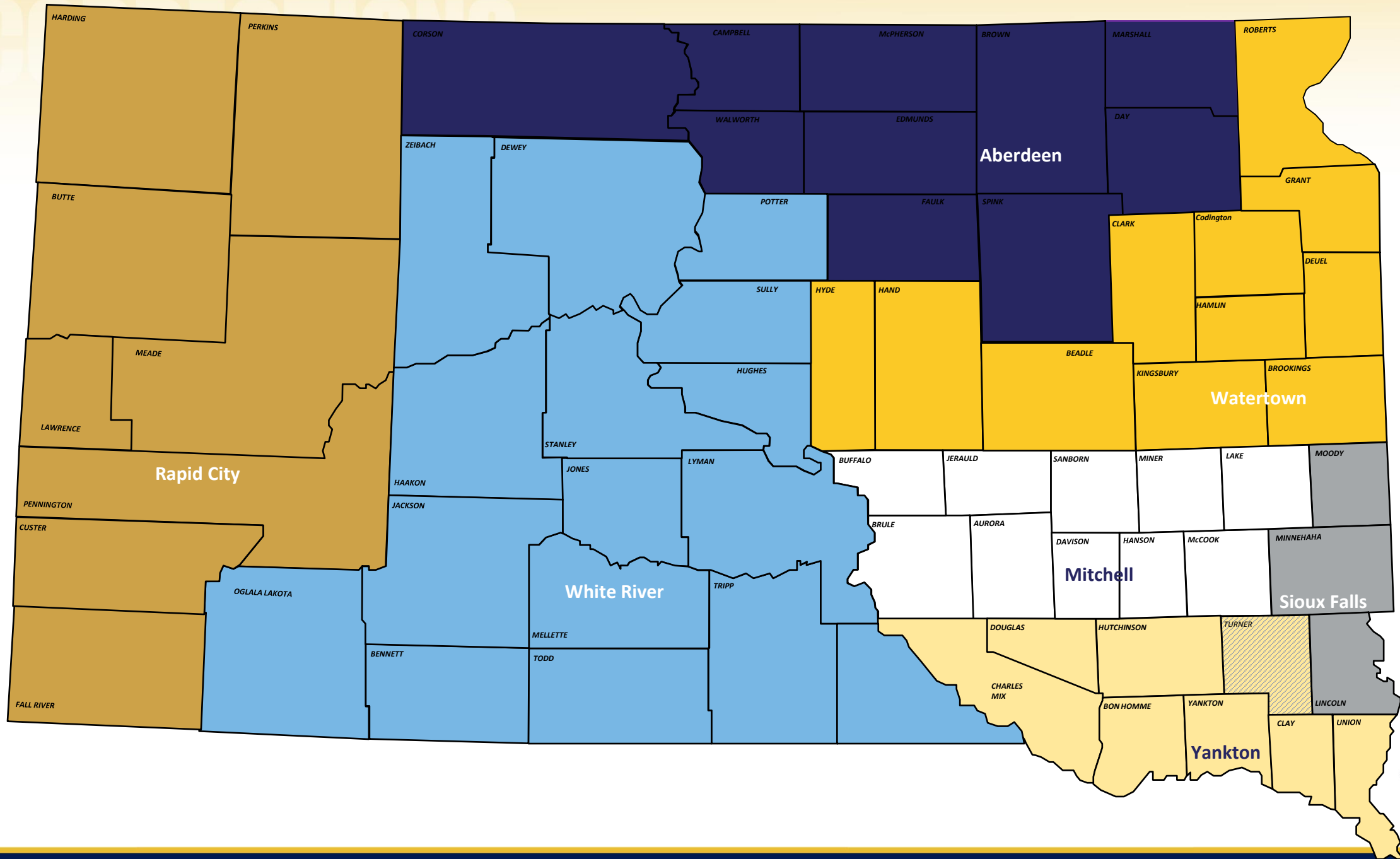

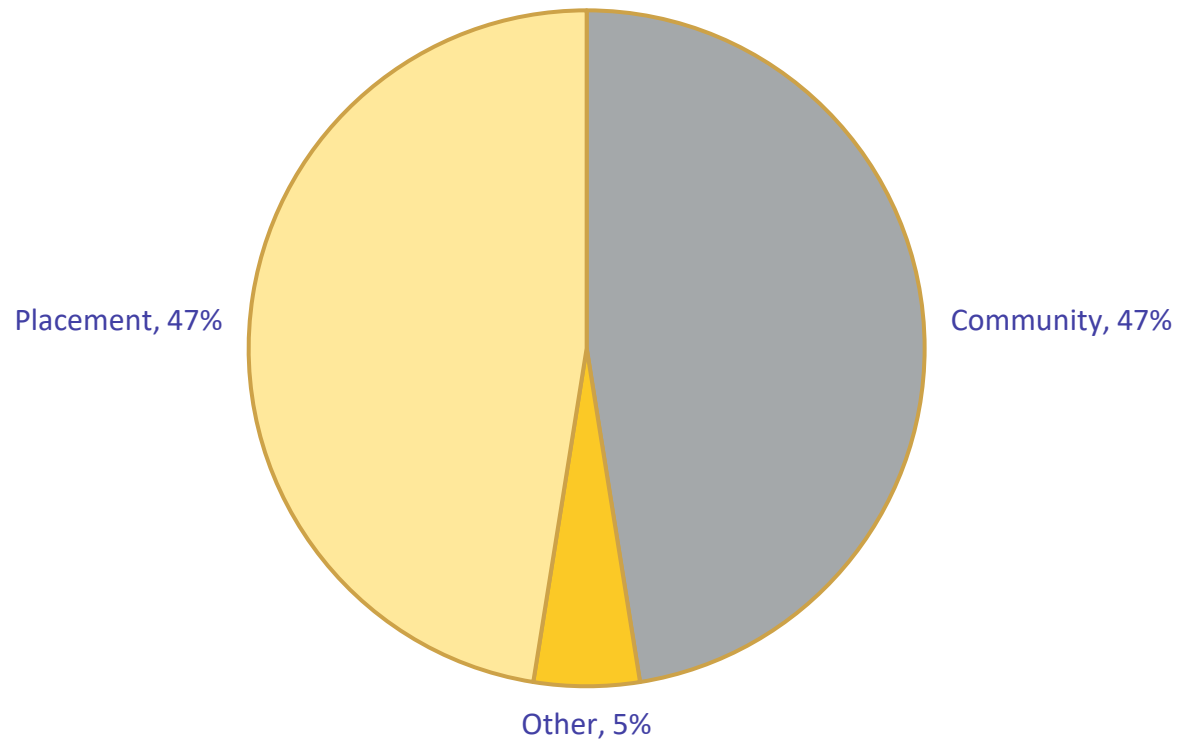




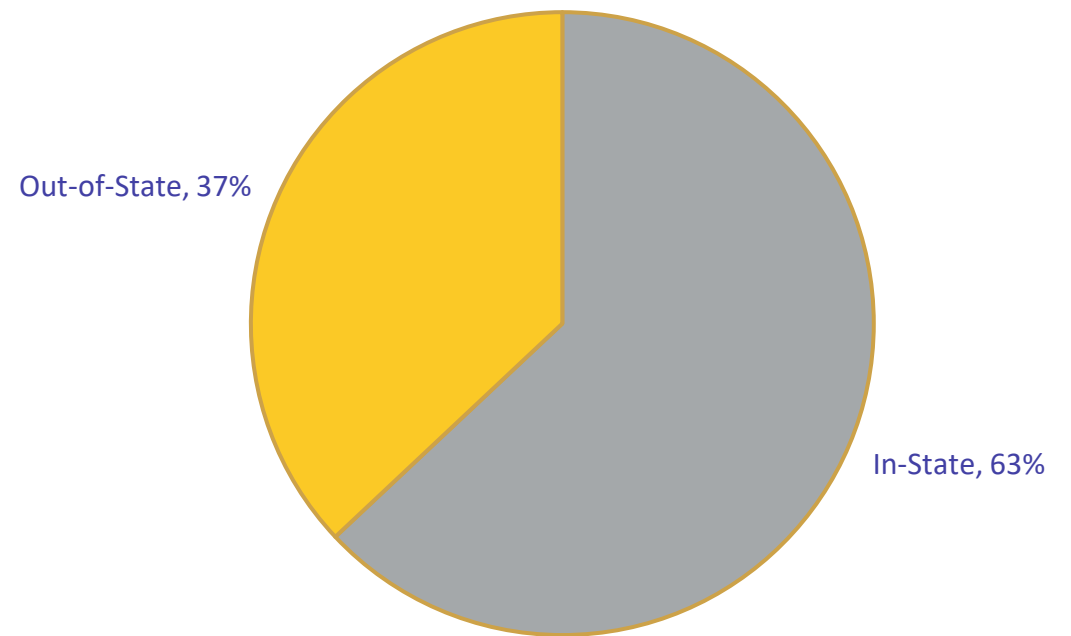

Community vs. Placement

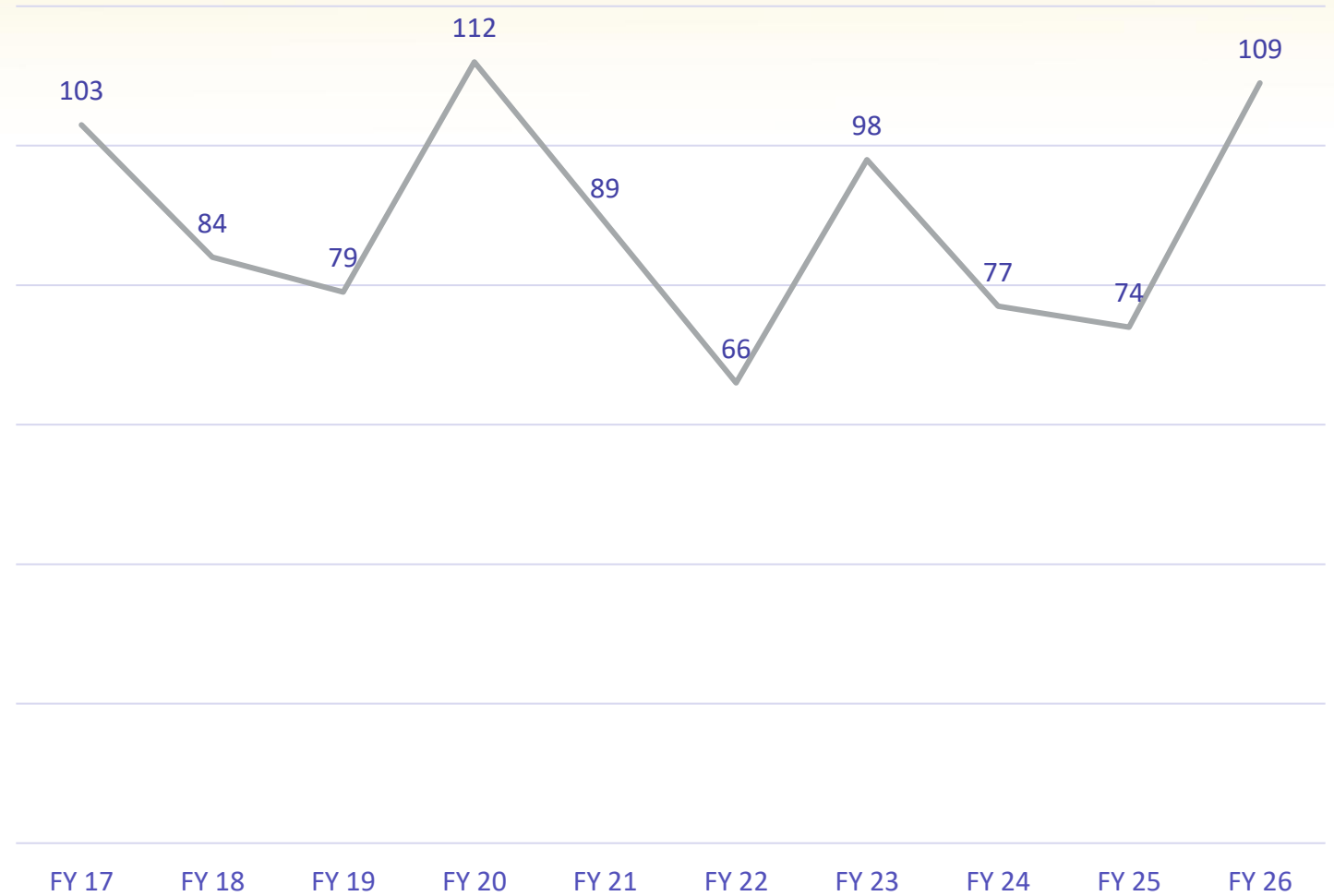
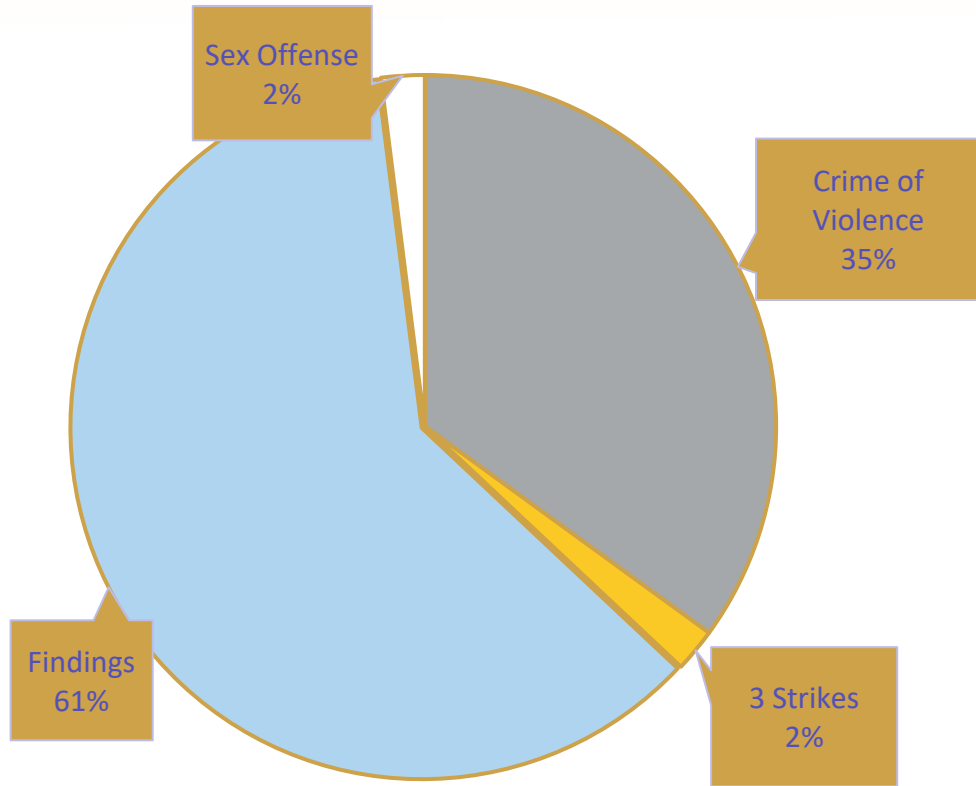


In-state vs. Out-of-State Placement

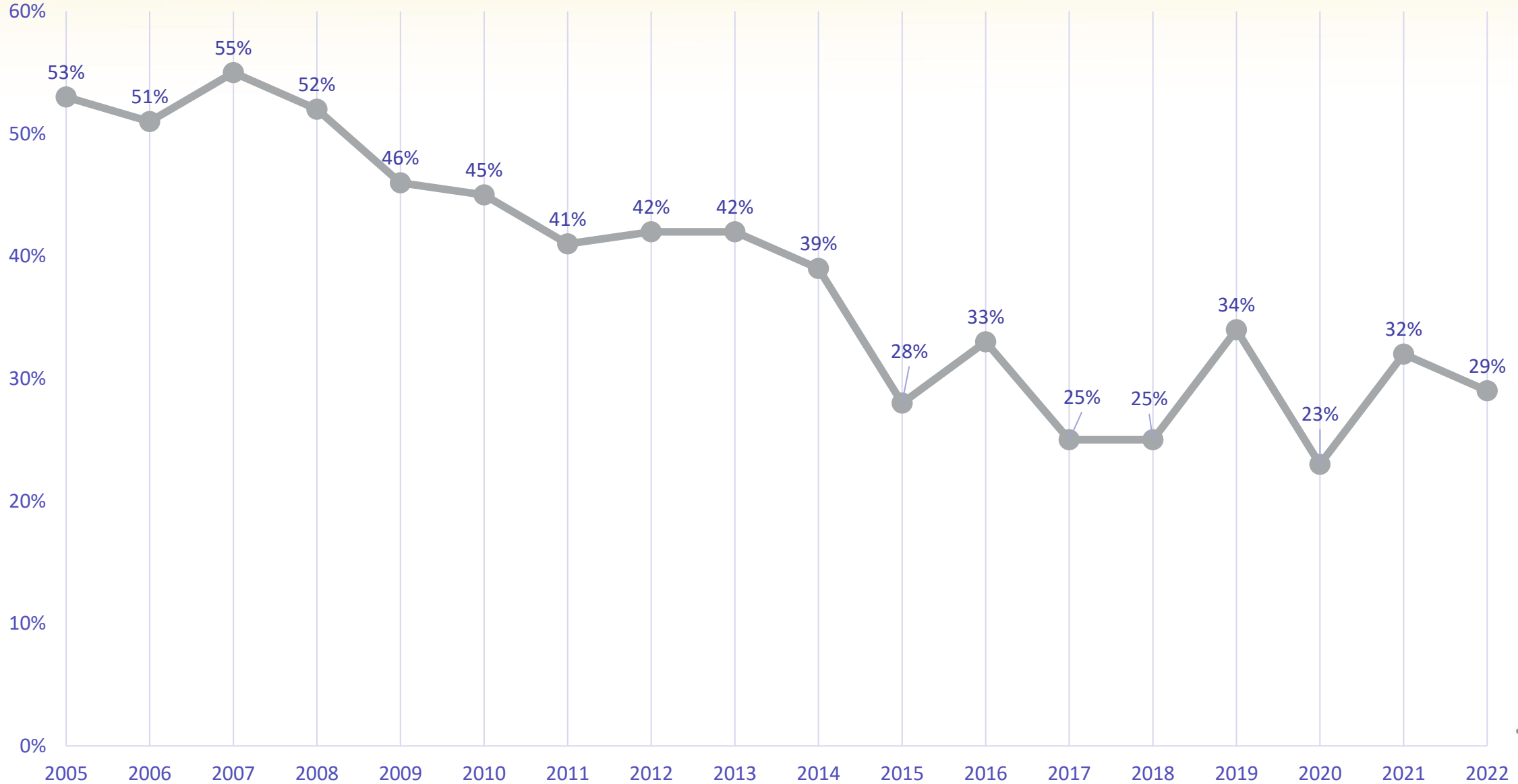


Youth in the Community and Improving Outcomes

- Increasing the usage of EPICS interventions, DBT skills, and Carey Guides.
- Continue to work with LSS for Strengthening Families.
- Thinking for a Change group continues in person and via tele-health throughout the state.



Recidivism Rate- 3 Year Measure



Juvenile Diversion (FY25) and Formula II Grants (JJDPa)

- Counties receive \$750 per successful diversion completion
- 85% of completions were successful, totaling 1,962 successful completions
- \$1,471,500 was paid out to counties
- Grants awarded for FY27: \$595,029.07





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
