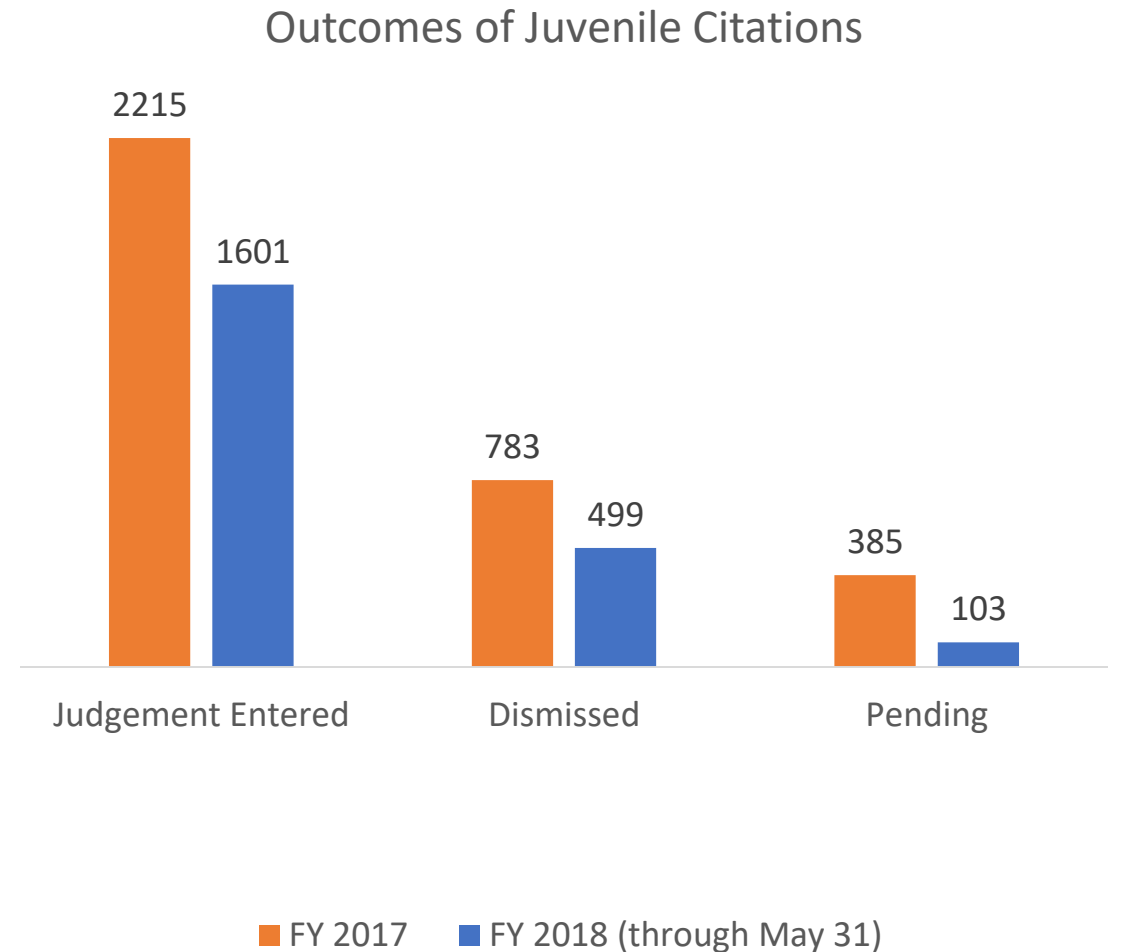

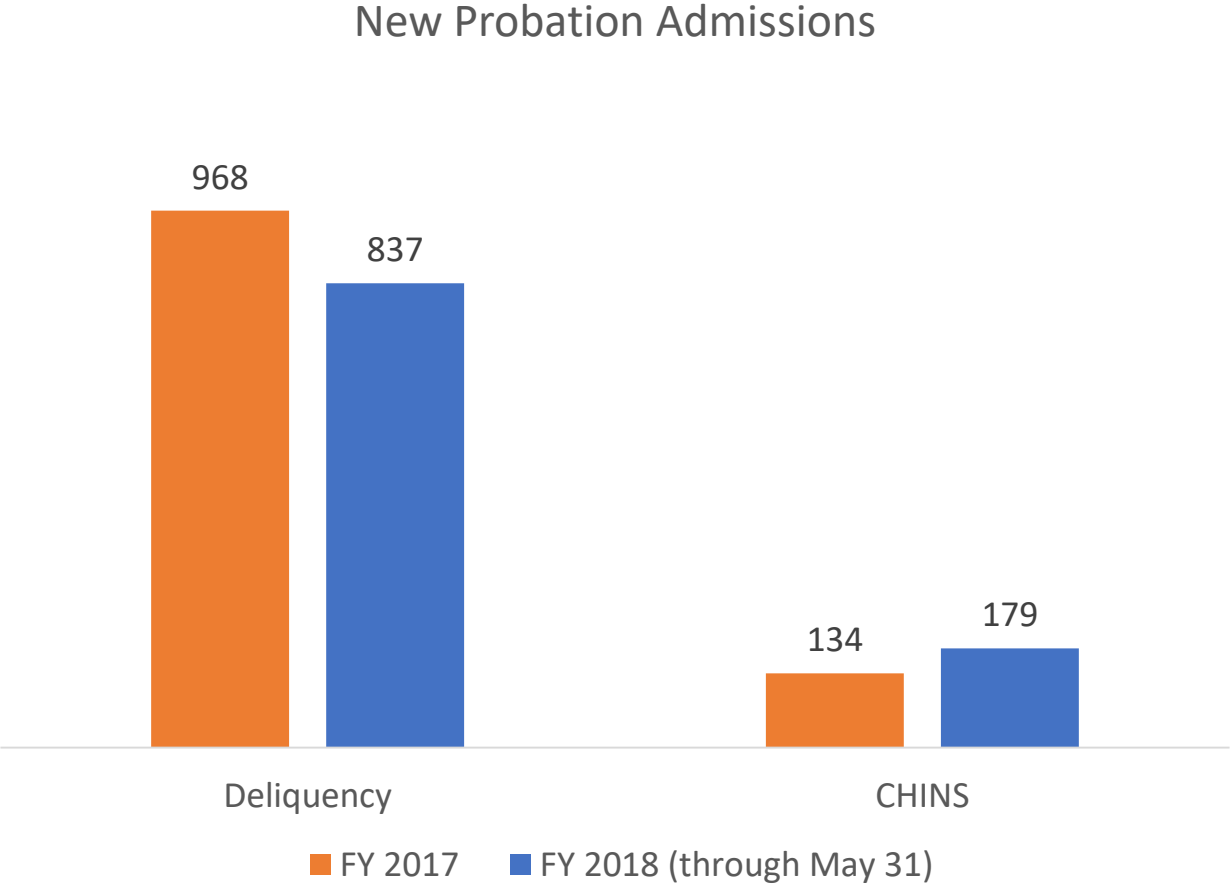
### Sanctions and Incentives



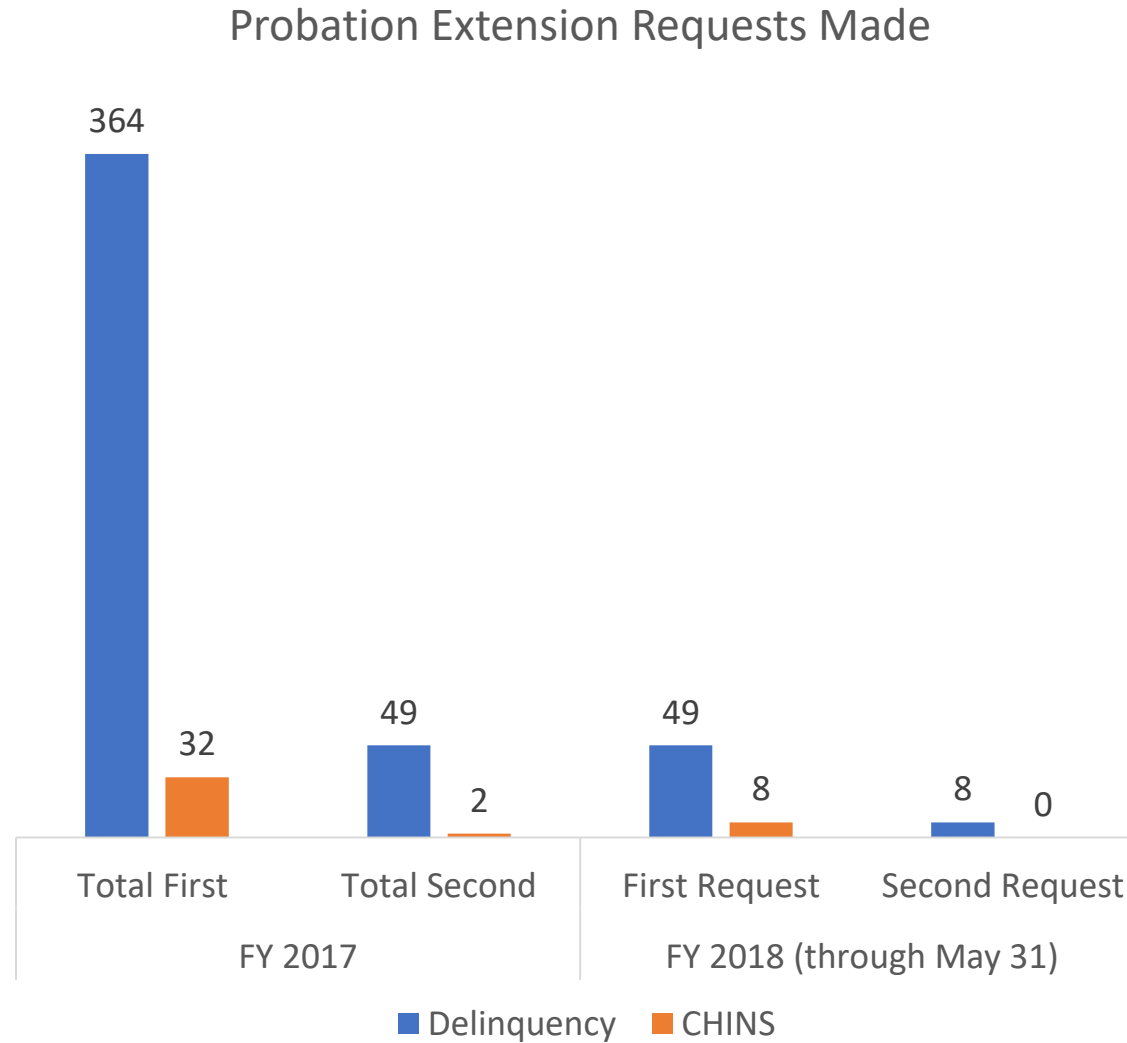
# Juvenile Citations have decreased in all four categories between FY 17 and FY 18 (through May 31).



**While the number of delinquency cases decreased 13 percent between FY 17 and FY 18, the number of CHINS cases increased 33 percent.**

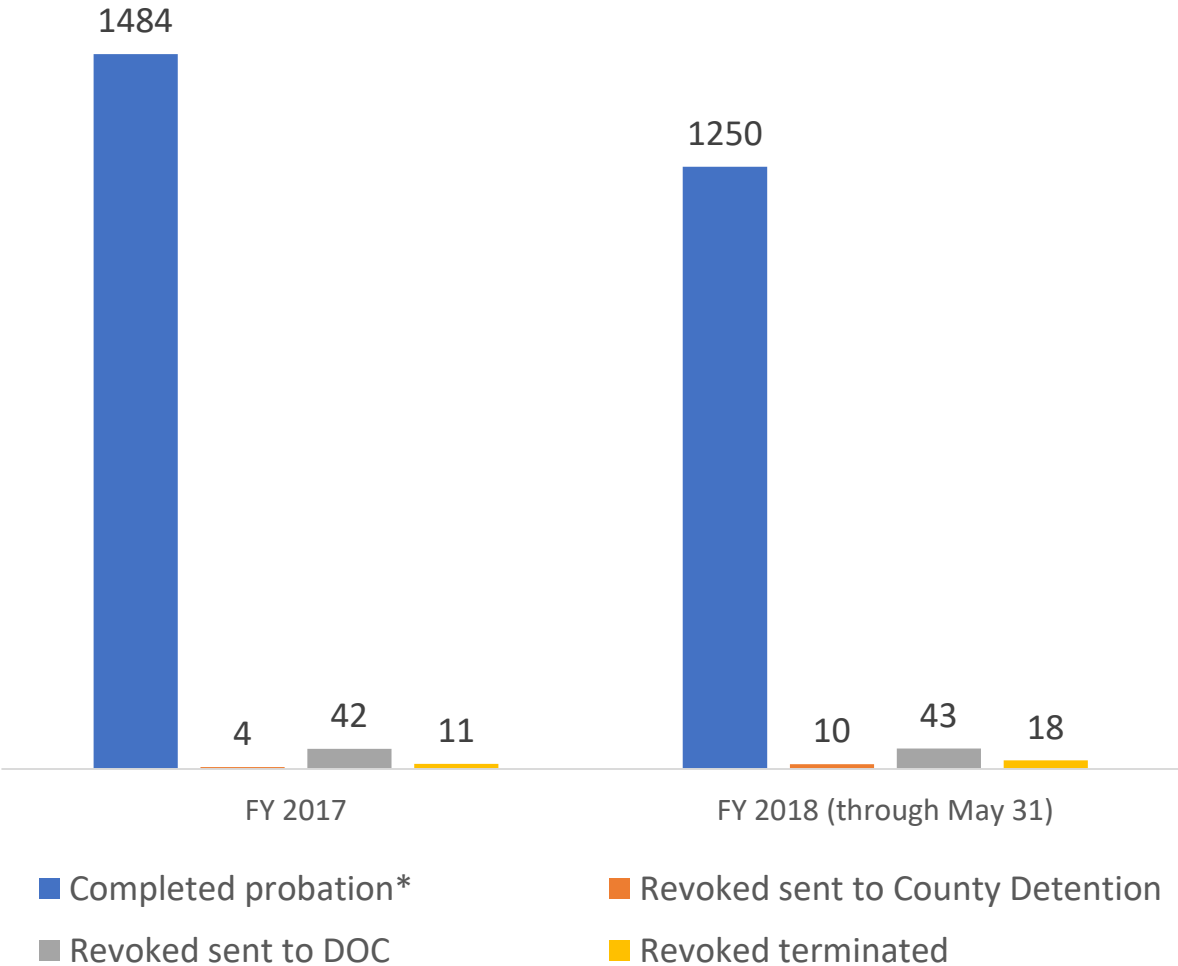


The number of probation extension requests decreased between FY 17 and FY 18.
