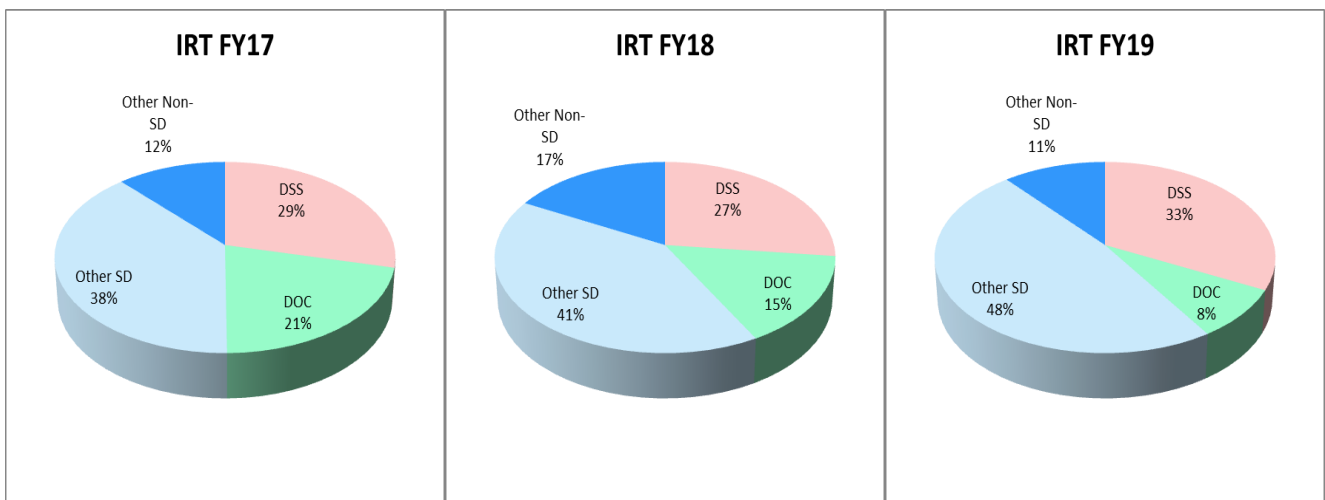
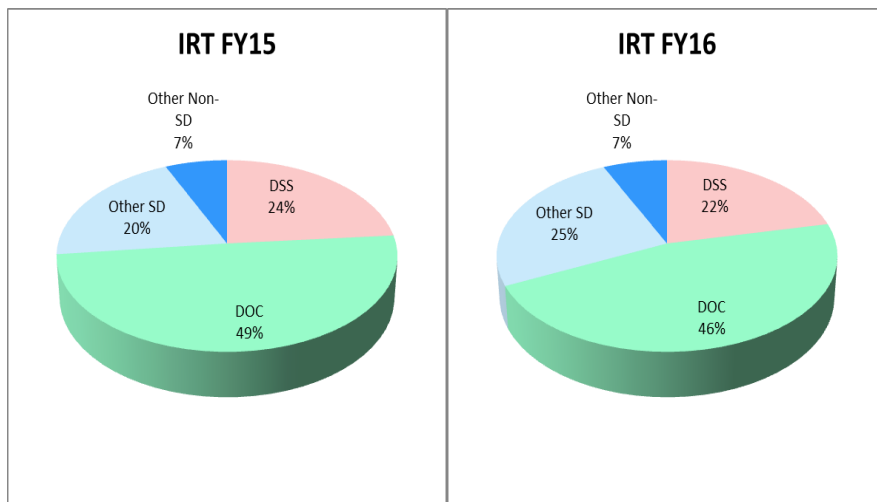
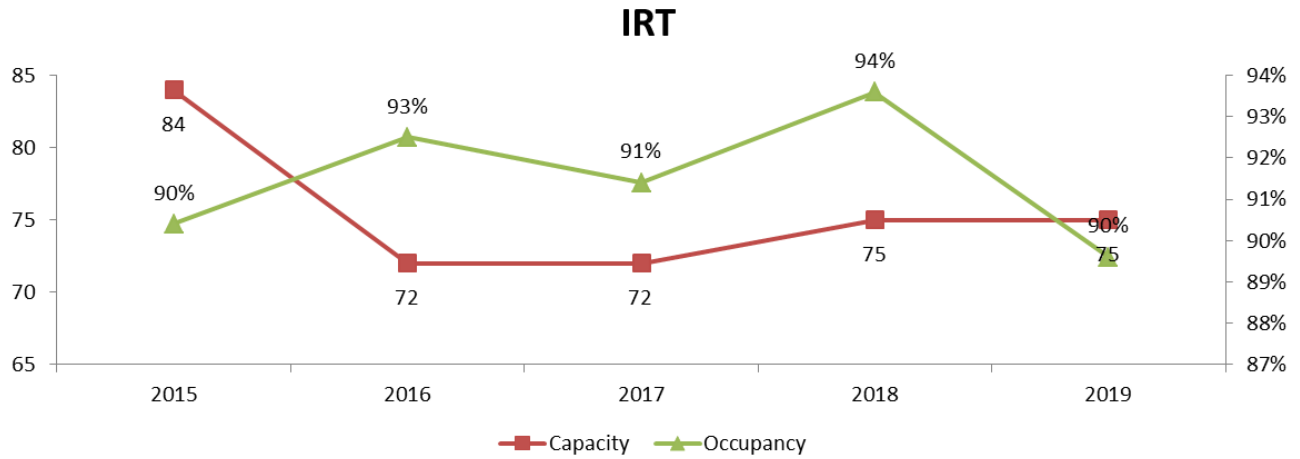
## Recent Capacity & Occupancy – Group Care

## CANS-Trauma Research in Residential Treatment

The Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths Trauma Comprehensive (CANS-Trauma) is a unique trauma-focused assessment strategy and multi-purpose tool. It is designed to integrate all the information gathered about the child and family in one place. Scoring involves 74 metrics across 7 categories, such as: Traumatic Stress Symptoms, Behavioral/Emotional Needs, Risk Behaviors and more. We track two metrics at intake and at discharge – the raw data and the actionable items. Actionable items are those that are scored at a higher level and require more attention.

### Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs)

Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) is the term used to describe types of abuse, neglect, and other potentially traumatic experiences that occur to people under the age of 18. Adverse Childhood Experiences have been linked to risky health behaviors, chronic health conditions, low life potential, and early death. As the number of ACEs increases, so does the risk for these outcomes.

This data shows that with higher levels of care come youth with higher Adverse Childhood Experiences and higher treatment needs when it comes to trauma.
