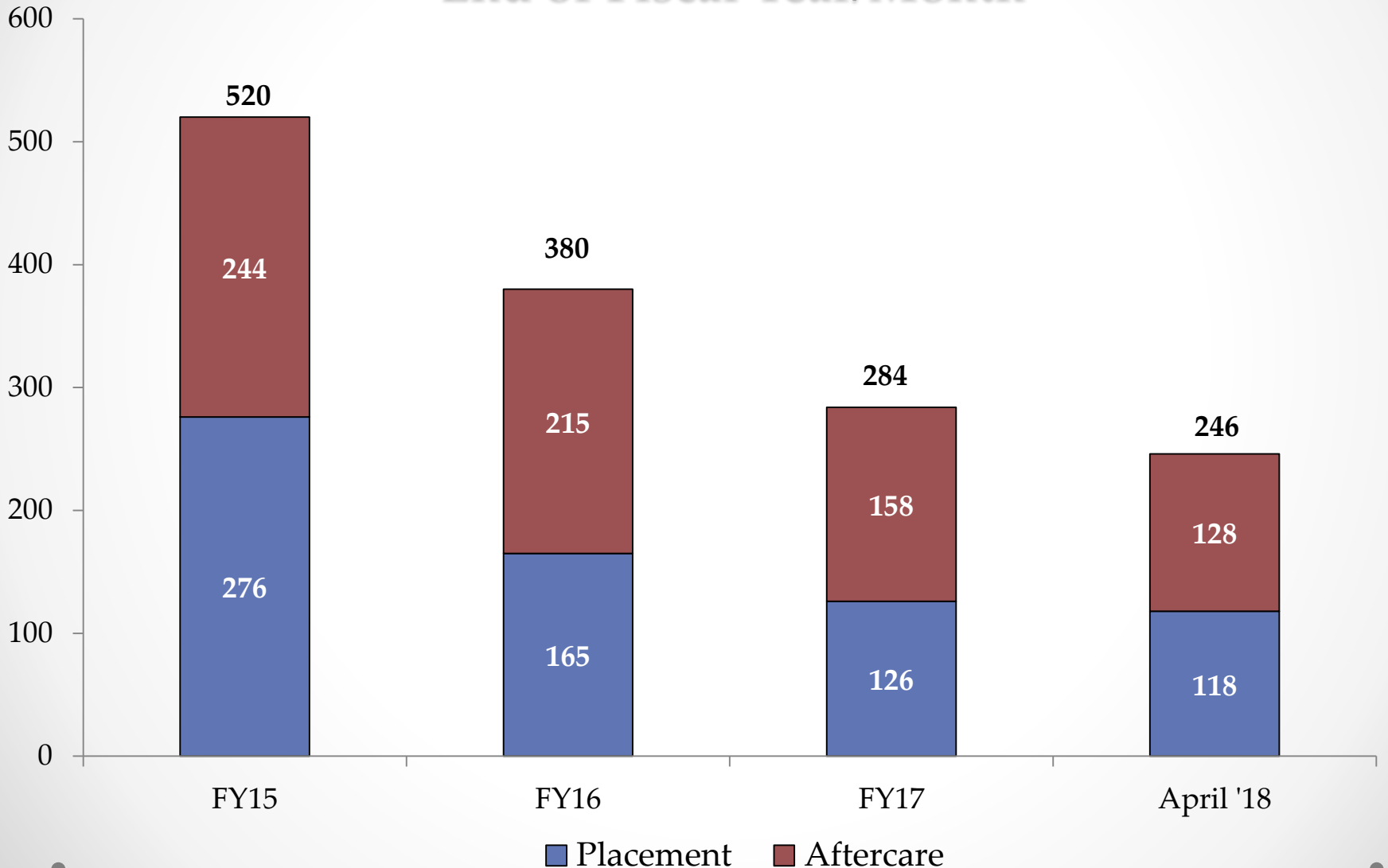

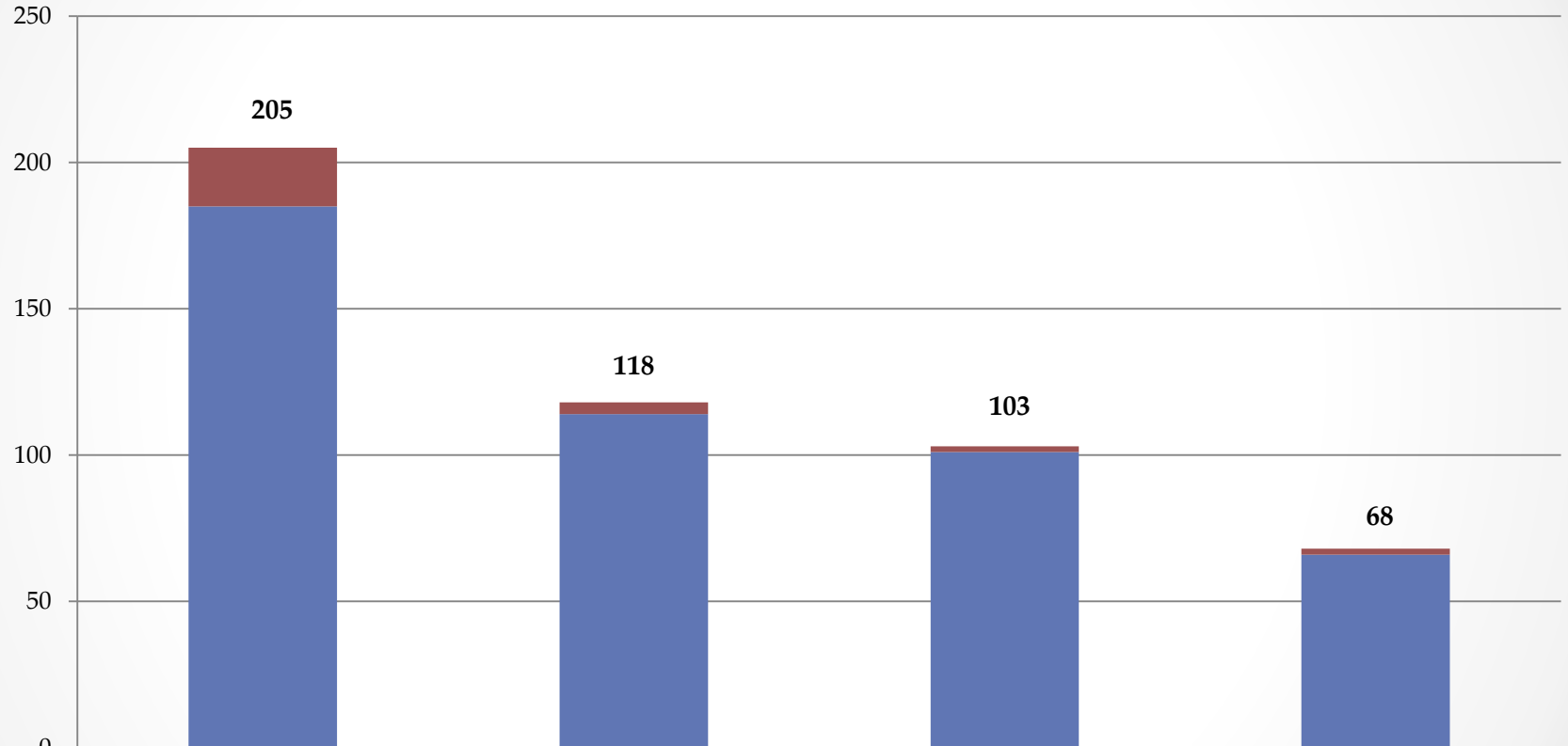

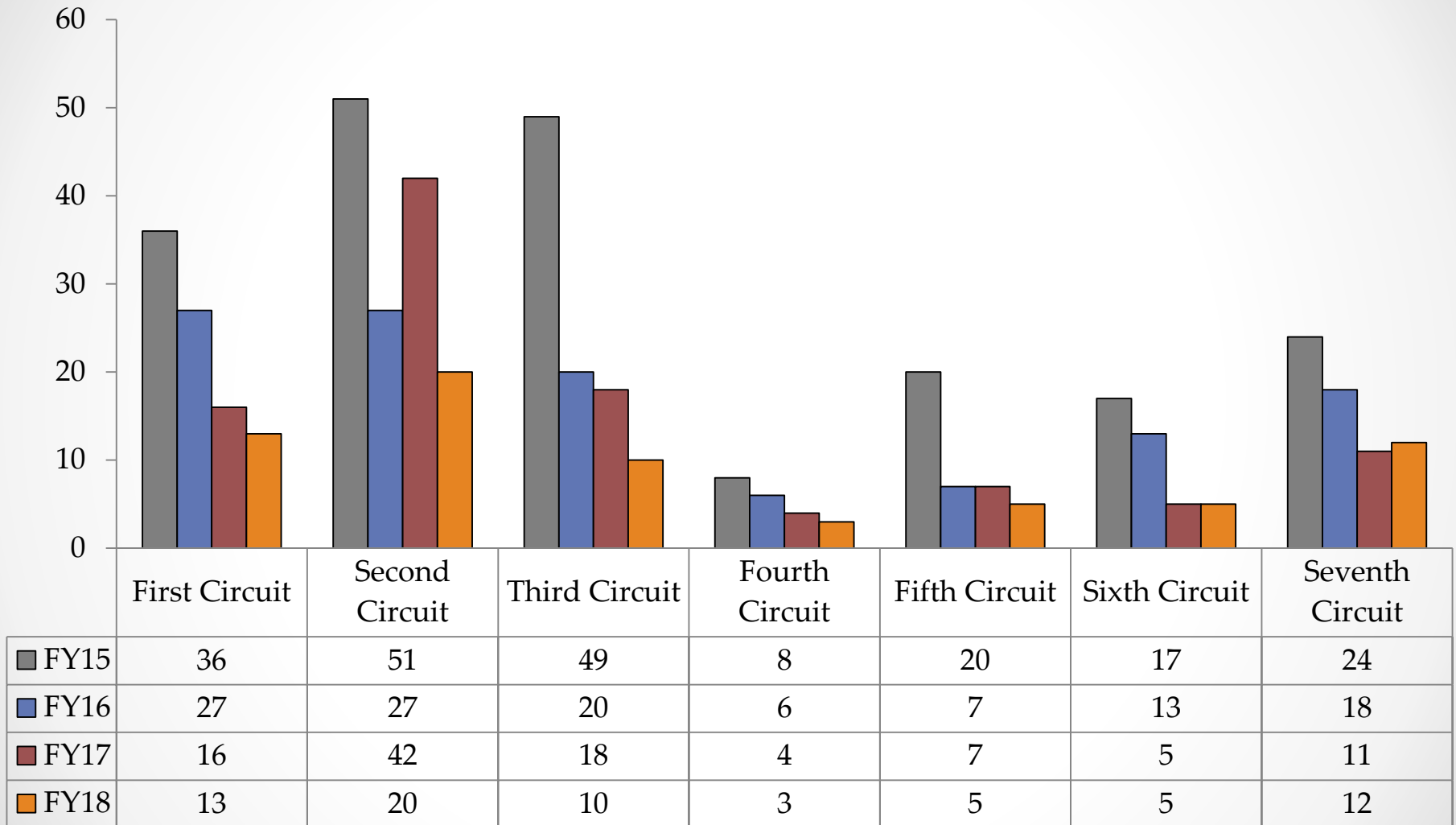

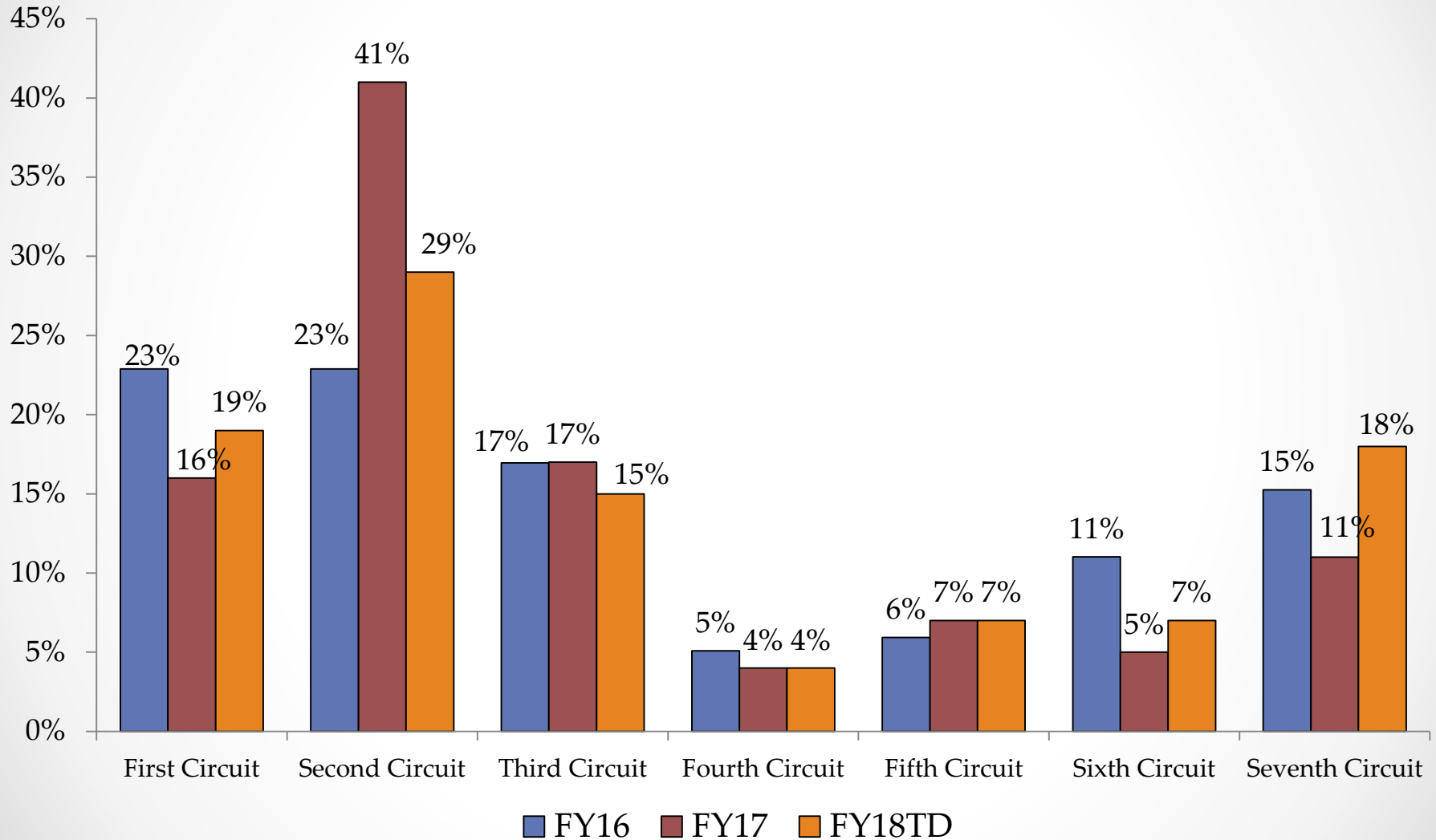

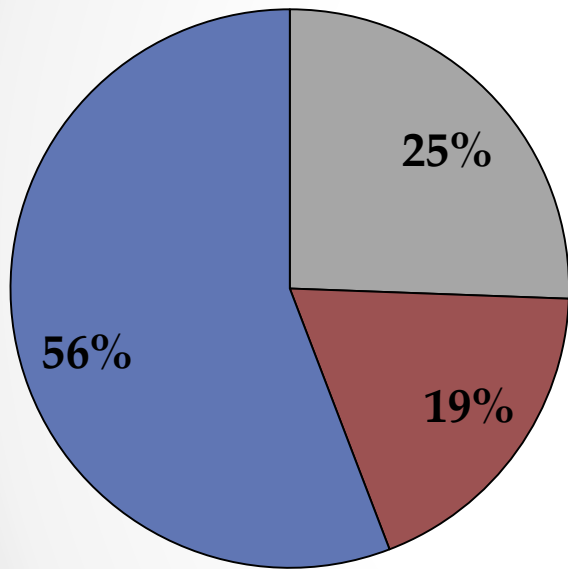
# Percentage of New Commitments By Circuit

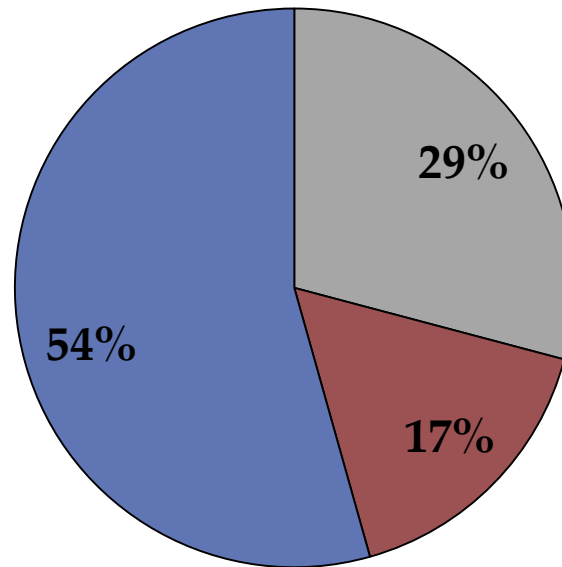

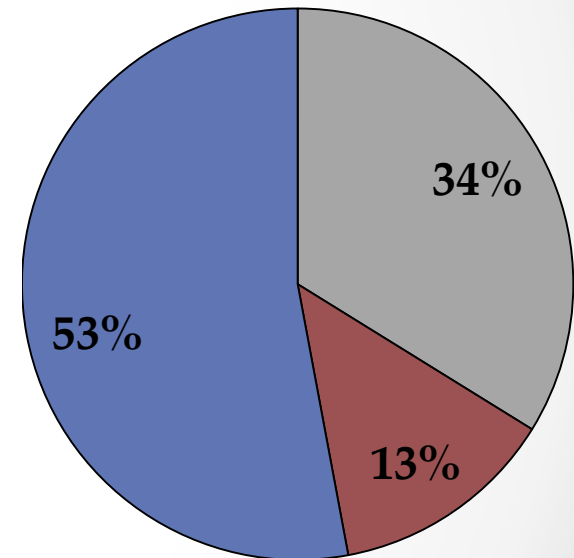

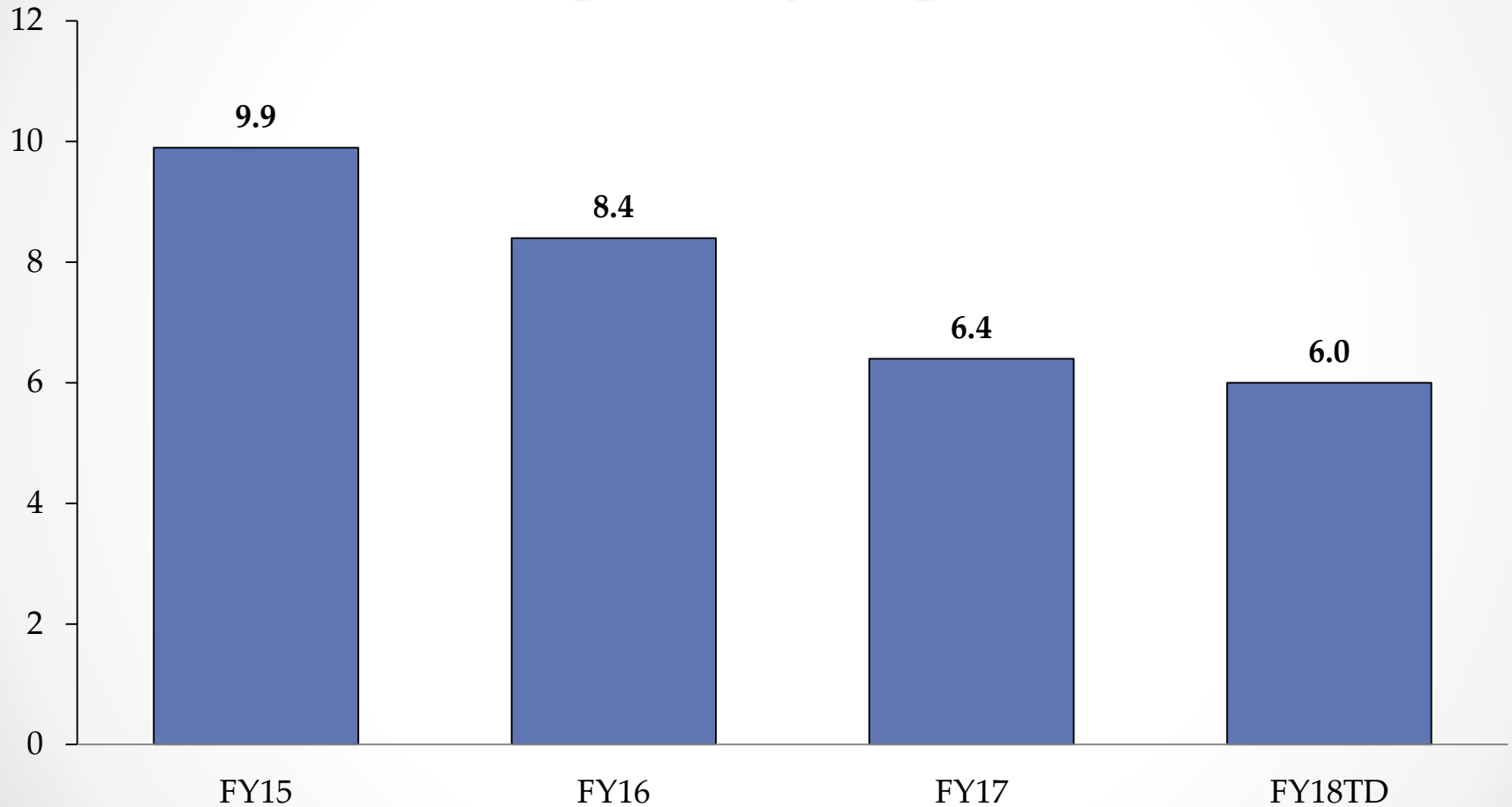

# Detention Cost Sharing Program

- The Detention Cost-Sharing Program was established in Senate Bill 73 to assist counties with increased juvenile detention costs that might be attributed to the reforms.
- Counties that experienced an increase in juvenile detention bed-days when compared to their 2013-2015 three-year average would be eligible to receive a \$200 for each bed day over the average.
- Payments are to be prorated if the total amount due exceeds the \$150,000 appropriation.
- Thirty-one counties submitted detention data for 2017.



# 2017 Detention Cost-Sharing Payments

- The following table shows reimbursement amounts for the fifteen counties whose 2017 detention bed-days exceeded their 2013-2015 three-year average.
