

Rules Overview

- For multi-state games, the SD Lottery adopts the game group as our rules for the game.
- That is what is being proposed for both Lucky for Life as well as Powerball and Double Play which is an add-on game for Powerball.
- The proposed administrative rule amendments do some clean-up but more importantly update the reference to the most current version of the multi-state game group rules.

Powerball/Double Play

Powerball

- As mentioned at the last Lottery Commission meeting, Powerball is moving from the current drawing of two days per week to three days per week.
- No changes are being proposed to the base Powerball game prize levels or odds.

Powerball Rules

- The primary focus is changing the date to reference the amended date of February 4, 2021, as the new game group rules. This is seen in 48:03:06:05.
- The proposed start date for the Monday drawing and the Double Play add on is Monday, August 23, 2021.

Double Play

- Double Play is an add on feature. Power Play is an add on feature.
- Gives Players that choose to participate a second chance of winning the same numbers played.
- How it works:
 - The Double Play option costs \$1. You must purchase the base Powerball game.
 - A second drawing of 5 white ball numbered from 1 to 69 and 1 red ball numbered 1 to 26.
 - Players who opt into Double Play will have a second chance to match their base game numbers.
 - The drawing will be held immediately following the Powerball drawing.
 - If you chose Double Play, the players numbers for the base game drawing will be used to match the numbers drawn for Double Play.
- Play mechanics the same as base game.
- Players have two chances to match their numbers.

Double Play Prize Structure

- There are 9 prize levels
- Overall odds are 1 in 24.87; Top prize odds are 1 in 292 million
- Double Play is designed to pay back 50.17%
- Prize money is concentrated on low/mid tier prizes.
- Top Prize is a fixed prize of \$10 million. Pari-mutuel if more than 1 winner at that level.
- 8 set cash prize levels.

Lucky for Life

- As mentioned at the two previous meetings, Lucky for Life is moving from the current drawing two days a week to seven days a week.
- Pretty straightforward
- No changes to the prize levels or odds are being proposed.
- The primary focus is changing the date to reference the amended date of December 11, 2020, as the new game group rules. This is seen in 48:03:18:04.
- The proposed start date for daily drawings is Monday, July 19, 2021.

Next Steps

- If the Commission approves the proposed rules amendments, the next step is the Legislative Rules Review Committee on May 10.
- Should the Legislative Rules Review Committee approve the rules, rules will become effective 10 days after filing with Secretary of the State's office.
