

2021 Legislation and Budget

April 1, 2021



An Act to revise and clarify certain provisions regarding the required minimum distribution methods of the South Dakota Retirement System.

- Added specific language relating to Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs)
 - Formerly referenced federal regulations
 - RMDs impact:
 - Supplemental Pension Benefit (SPB)
 - SDRS retirement benefit
 - Supplemental Retirement Plan (SRP)
 - Special Pay Plan (SPP)
 - Department of Labor retirement benefit



An Act to revise certain provisions relating to the South Dakota Retirement System.

- Removed notary requirements and added requirement for copy of photo identification
- Revised terminology and process for crediting contributions not used in calculation of final average compensation
- Corrected cross references



An Act to revise the minimum cost of living adjustment and revise terminology of the South Dakota Retirement System.

- Reduced minimum cost of living adjustment (COLA) to 0%
- Replaced the term, annual increase, with **COLA** throughout chapter



An Act to update certain provisions relating to the South Dakota Retirement System, to revise certain provisions relating to reemployment after retirement with the South Dakota Retirement System, and to declare an emergency.

- Clarified what constitutes a separation from service no employment regardless of classification as part-time, seasonal, temporary, leased, contract, or any other designation
- Clarified that bona fide separation is required before returning to work
- Provided exception for part-time employment if member is 59 ¹/₂ when retirement benefit starts and works less than 1250 hours in the employer's FY
- Removed suspension of benefit for retiree with reduced benefit upon returning to work
- Revised definitions and reconciled terminology
- Included emergency clause so legislation effective April 1, 2021



Other Legislation

Enacted

- SB 85. An Act to modify the composition of the Retirement Laws Committee. Schoenbeck
 - Committee proportionate to the party's representation; at least one minority member
- HB 1127. An Act to revise certain provisions regarding official meetings conducted by teleconference. Reed
 - Voice votes allowed during teleconference unless any member votes in the negative

Not Enacted

- HB 1117. An Act to revise provisions for public meetings held by teleconference. *Reed*
- HB 1128. An Act to establish requirements for public meeting notices and materials. *Mulally*
- HB 1129. An Act to establish requirements for livestreamed public meetings. *Mulally*



An Act to appropriate money for the ordinary expenses of the legislative, judicial, and executive departments of the state, the expenses of state institutions, interest on the public debt, and for common schools.

SDRS expenditure authority changes for FY 2022:

- Decrease of \$47,000 in other fund expenditure authority -Completed purchase of audio-visual equipment for new space and security enhancements for office
- Shift of \$87,021 in other fund expenditure authority from operating expenses to personal services - Hired full-time attorney to reduce contractual services of external legal counsel
