A Full Board meeting was held at Jameson Annex on March 11th, 2026, commencing at 9:13 a.m.

II. Call for Public Input

III. Parole Hearings

A. Arpan, Tanner

Board Members proceeded with the scheduled hearing of *Tanner Arpan*. The offender was present on Teams.

Chair Rau turned the proceedings over to himself and Board Member Hall for summarization. Testimony was provided by the offender. Following summarization, testimony, evidence review, questions and discussion, the following action was taken:

Board Members reviewed the denials of 4 pardons by the two-panels at Special Session. Motion by Aasen, second by Beck to ratify the decisions and adopt the denials. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

Board Members reviewed the minutes for the February 2026 meetings of the Board. Motion by Meyers, second by Steele to approve the February 2026 minutes. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

VII. Full Board Cases / Potential Upcoming Paper Review Cases

Board Members were advised that the April calendar has 3 full board cases currently scheduled. One of the cases will need to be scheduled for Tuesday afternoon to accommodate the offender's facility schedule.



VIII. April Proposed Schedule

Board Members reviewed the proposed schedule for April. Due to a lower number of full board cases in April, the board will hold its business meeting on Wednesday, April 15th, 2026, and not convene on April 16th, 2026. Board Members indicated whether they would be appearing via Teams. Board Members would like to try holding more hearing sessions and meetings over Teams from the Board Office at the Sioux Falls One Stop. The Board Chair will visit with the Board Administration Manager to review the meeting rooms that are available.

IX. Board Report / Field Services Report

Board Members reviewed the board report and monthly metrics. There was a Special Session held on February 26th; there were paper reviews of early discharges, pardons, and a commutation application, waivers (parole/SSV/non-compliance) signed, and parole revocation, suspended sentence, and non-compliance hearings. The current set-out period for pardons is May 2026.

X. Items for Discussion

Vice Chair Aasen would like to see additional data on recidivism. Board Chair Rau advised that he had an upcoming online meeting with Richard Stroker, Center for Effective Public Policy about a potential training opportunity.

XI. Policy Review

Board members reviewed Policy 8.1.A.5 Parole Board Decisions and Setting of Next Review Dates. Staff recommended no revisions to the policy at this time.
