Adopted General Fund Revenue Amount = \$1.7 billion

- Up \$5.6 million from Governor Noem's Budget Address
- \$55.7 million growth from FY 2019 revised budget to FY 2020 budget

Core Funding Proposals

- 2.5% for State Employee Salaries
 - Additionally, no monthly surcharge for health insurance
- 2.5% for K-12 per Student Allocation (Includes Technical Institutes)
- Medicaid Service Providers
 - Nursing Homes: 10% Increase
 - Community Support Providers: 6.5% Increase
 - Other Community-Based Providers: 3 4% Increase
 - Non-Community-Based Providers: Average of 1.5% Increase

DOR Budget

- \$75,518,971 & 254.5 FTE
- 4 New FTE: Revenue Agents (2) & Auditors (2)

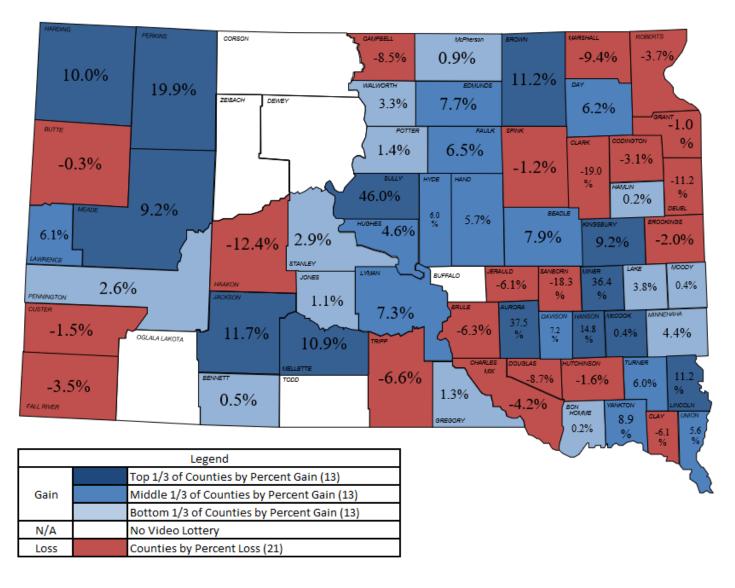

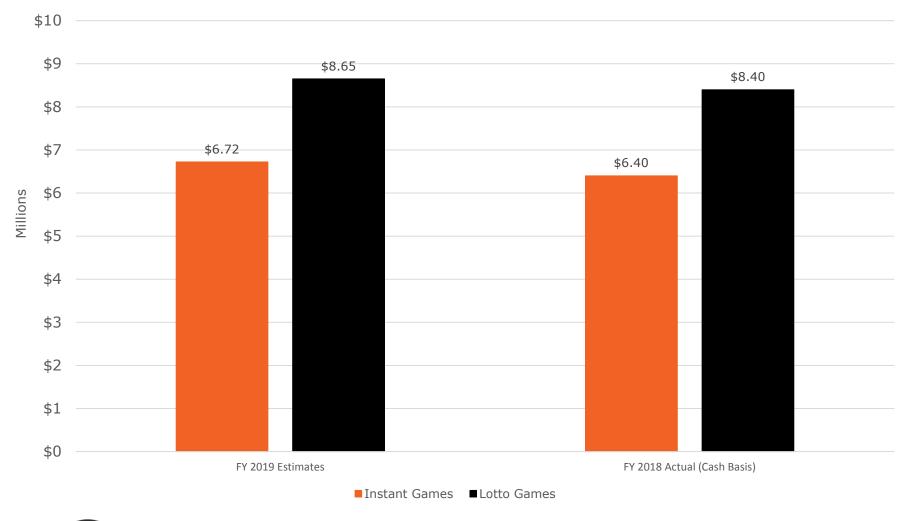

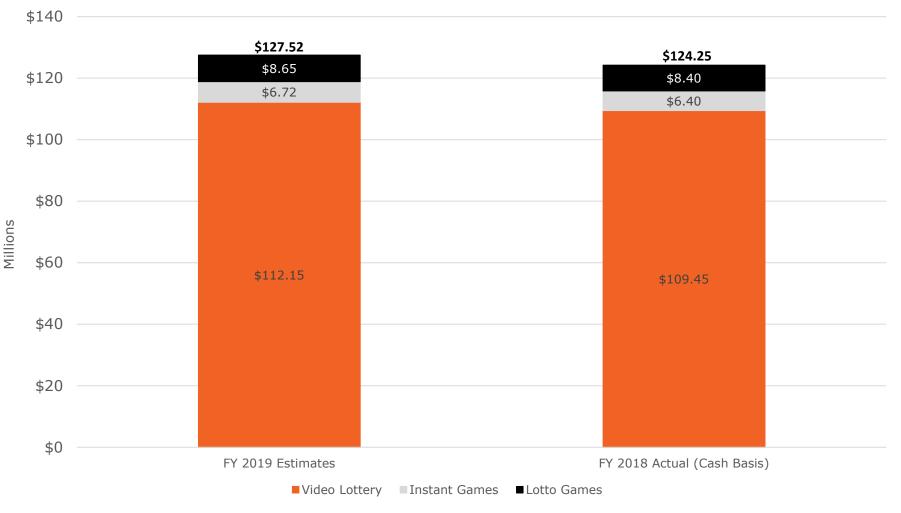


Instant and Online FY19 Revenue Projections as of February 28, 2019

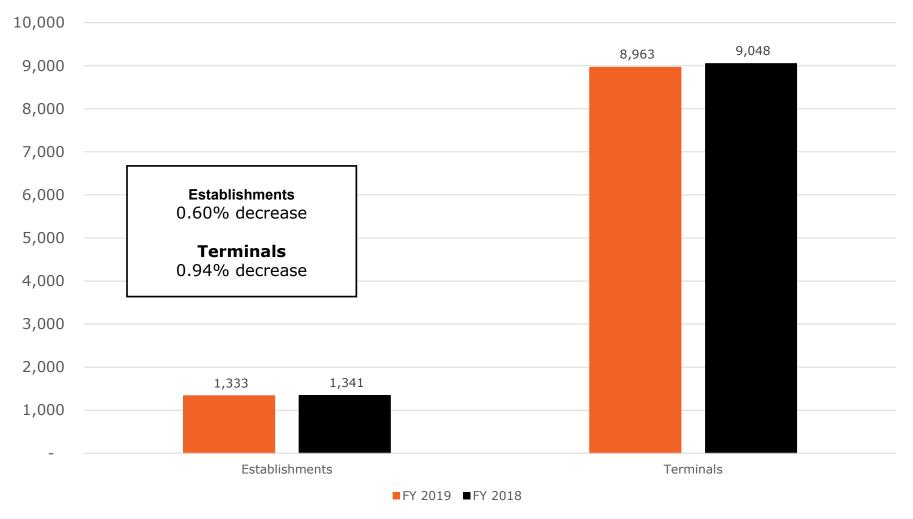




Video Lottery Report



Number of Terminals and Establishments as of February 2019



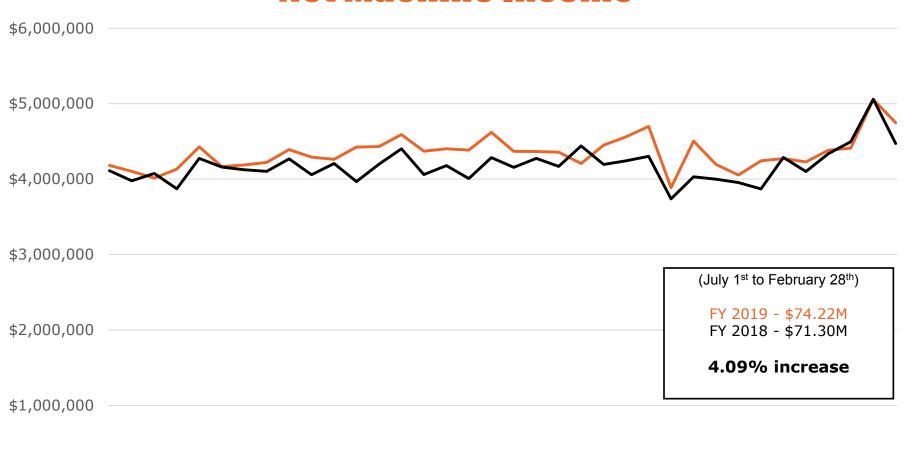


Video Lottery FY 19 State Share Revenue Projection as of February 28, 2019

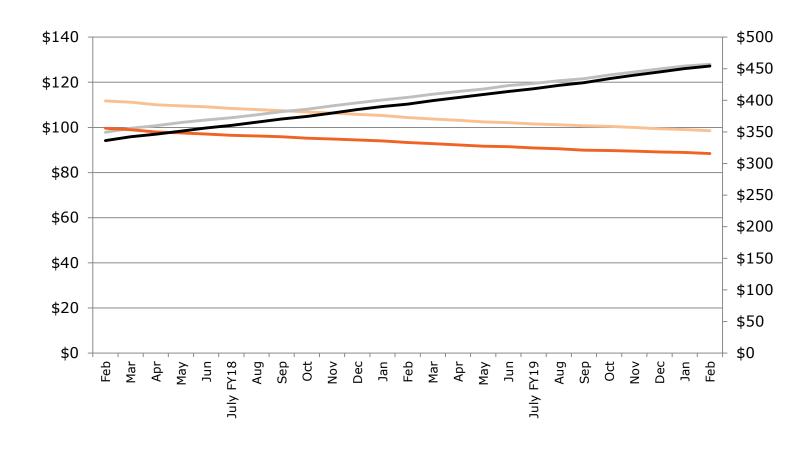

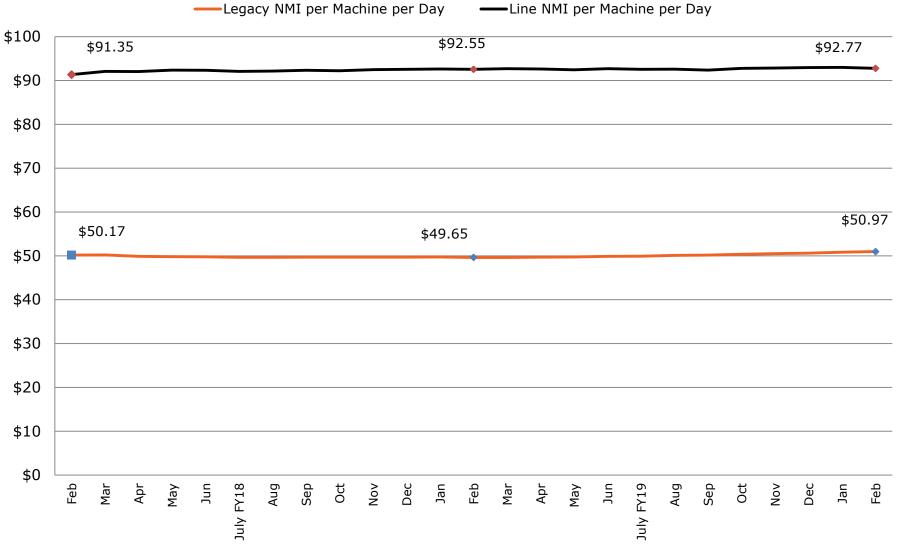
