

MINUTES OF THE SOUTH DAKOTA ANNUAL WEED & PEST CONTROL COMMISSION MEETING 1
February 16, 2022 – 1 pm
Crossroads Hotel and Huron Event Center, Huron, SD

Vice-Chairman Craig Magedanz called the meeting to order at 1:00 pm, February 16, 2022.

Members Present: Commissioners Dennis Feickert, Duane Buckmeier, Craig Magedanz, Bruce Helbig, Darwin Kurtenbach, Game Fish & Parks representative Paul Coughlin, Association of SD County Commissioners Representative Brenda Hanten; Department of Transportation Representative Thomas Druyvestein; Non-Voting Member - SDSU Representative Paul Johnson; and Commission Secretary and Plant Industry Program Manager Brenda Sievers. Duane Buckmeier made a motion to approve the agenda (Exhibit #2). Seconded by Paul Coughlin. Motion carried.

Vice-Chairman Magedanz presented the Committee recommendations for funding the FY2023 Competitive Grants. The Committee met on January 5th in Pierre. The Committee consisted of Vice-Chairman Magedanz, SD Game Fish & Parks Representative Paul Coughlin, then School & Public Lands Commissioner Ryan Brunner, SDSU Representative Paul Johnson and Department of Agriculture Representative Bill Smith.

The Committee recommended not funding the following Competitive Grants:

WP-C23-14 – Butte County - Hoary Cress/Common Mullein/Poison Hemlock Educational Mailing & Chemical Cost Share (\$10,000)
WP-C23-16 – Butte County - Absinth Wormwood, Burdock, Common Tansy, Houndstongue & Leafy Spurge (\$21,000)

The Committee recommended funding the following Competitive Grants at a reduced amount:

WP-C23-1 – Hyde County - Transline Shelterbelt Canada Thistle Control Project – reduced by \$6,000
WP-C23-2 – Hyde County - Milestone Absinth Wormwood Control Project – reduced by \$2,500
WP-C23-3 – Fall River County - Salt Cedar Clean Up - Fall River County -reduced by \$12,500
WP-C23-4 – Fall River County - Hoary Cress Assistance - Fall River County – reduced by \$2,000
WP-C23-13 – Hughes County - Control Wormwood Sage in Residential Areas – reduced by \$1,000

The Committee recommended funding the following Competitive Grants:
