(1) Amended rule 20:18:16:15.23. Variations of the play – Dakota Duel Draw. The effect of this amendment is to add additional paytables for the game.

The reason for this amendment is a request from the game's originator, James Reed.

(2) Amended rule 20:18:35:01. Definitions. The effect of this amendment is to clarify the definition of a prohibited person.

The reason for this amendment is to provide clarity and to follow the recommendations from Legislative Research Council Code Counsel.

(3) Amended rule 20:18:35:18. Tournaments, contests, and pools. The effect of this amendment is to clarify the requirements for notification to the Commission.

The reason for this amendment is to provide clarity and to follow the recommendations from Legislative Research Council Code Counsel.

(4) Amended rule 20:18:35.01:03. Certification Testing. The effect of this amendment is to clarify the requirements for submissions to an independent testing laboratory.

(5) Amended rule 20:18:35.01:12. Test accounts. The effect of this amendment is to clarify the requirements that a licensee or sports wagering services provider must address in establishing test accounts.

(6) Amended rule 20:18:35.02:05. Winning wagers and vouchers. The effect of this amendment is to delete the recording information for vouchers and place them in a separate rule for clarity.

The reason for this amendment is to provide clarity and to follow the recommendations from Legislative Research Council Code Counsel.

(7) Proposed new rule 20:18:35.02:05.01. Vouchers – System recording requirements. The effect of this new rule is to clarify the requirements of the system recordings for vouchers which was previously set forth in 20:18:35.02:05.

(8) Amended rule 20:18:36:18. Account credits and deposits. The effect of this amendment is to clarify the accounts credits and deposits and approved methods of funding.

(9) Amended rule 20:18:36:27. Suspension and restoration of accounts. The effect of this amendment is to clarify the suspension and restoration of accounts.

(10) Proposed new rule 20:18:36:27.01. Suspension of account -- effect. The effect of this new rule is to clarify the effects of suspension of an account.

(11) Amended rule 20:18:36:36. Securing payment methods. The effect of this amendment is to clarify methods of securing payments.
