
Oceti Sakowin Essential Understandings & Standards Needs Assessment

The Oceti Sakowin Essential Understandings and Standards (OSEU) Needs Assessment survey was administered by the South Dakota Department of Education (SDDOE) to understand the implementation of the OSEU and the professional development support and resources needed to implement the OSEU in South Dakota schools. The survey was first administered in the early fall of 2021 and then again in the late fall of 2023.

Comparison of 2021 & 2023 Administrator Survey Results

Awareness & Importance of the OSEU

In 2023, administrators were more likely to report . . .



Integrate local communities into schools to provide support that goes beyond paper and pencil. Assemblies, drum presentations, Native American heritage month activities in the schools.

In 2023, 45% of administrators reported their district has a school-board approved policy requiring OSEU implementation (an increase of 28% from 2021).
