
New Business


1. System Upgrade Status.

- Completed, upgrade of system core to 7.19
- NICE recording system upgraded.
- GenWatch, a system diagnostic and reporting system has been installed.
- Critical Connect, the system interconnect, LTE interface, and PTT app is next.
- We are down to approximately one year before the first legacy system P25 conversion takes place for the Rapid City simulcast system. The following year will be something everyone needs to be ready for.

2. Reliance, Hot Springs, & Hills projects outlines.

- Reliance, \$400k, uses existing SDPB tower & building. Chamberlain, Oacoma, Lower Brule and Crow Creek reservation areas.
- Hot Springs, \$400k, uses existing Battle Mountain tower & building. Improved coverage in Hot Springs & southern hills area.
- Hills, \$2.4M, cooperative project with Pennington County who will arrange for sites (land, tower, buildings), and state will provide communications equipment, antennas & feedline.
- Equipment mounted in Reliance & Hot Springs, antenna work being scheduled, circuits on order. Still hoping for a completion of the two sites before the end of the year. Site construction for hills sites underway.





3. Site Prioritization Update

- This is still not a process that has advanced much since our attention on this in 2020.
- Would like to be able to report some progress with the 2022 Legislative session. I will circle up with Gary Jaeger of the SDACCO & see if we can make some progress.

4. Critical Connect/WAVE System

 This is the next step of the upgrade, having completed the core upgrade, the NICE logging recorder upgrade, and adding the GenWatch product that will allow us to diagnose and report on system and user radio issues. Critical Connect is the platform that will allow us at some point to incorporate directly with LTE, as well as being a much-improved version of the PTT app that we currently utilize. I am hoping by the December meeting we will be completed or far enough into the process to have a practical overview for the meeting

5. FY23 Budget Request

These items are NOT final budget requests, only those items submitted upward for approval.

- ~\$500,000 in expected support cost increases associated with the system going live in FY23.
- \$140,000 for replacement of the White River tower (one-time).
- \$60,000 recurring for the public safety app Bridge4PS.
- Requested funding for a possible site in the Redfield area.

6. Bridge4PS application. Rollout and Status

- Purchased limited number of licenses to get things started & begin to set policies.
- If not approved during session in 2022, will need to regroup & possibly leverage the free licenses more until we regroup. Planned to distribute 1-2 Pro licenses per agency.


7. Aberdeen PD Request for Patching

- Request from Communications Manager of Brown County and PD Captain Johndal to develop processes and protocols to communicate from their system to the statewide system when emergency team coordination needs to take place.
- Patching to a specific SP OPS talkgroup. Brown County PSAP has limited channel space available, the control radios are in a different location than the consoles, so they have some challenges.
- Patching to the ABDN INT talkgroup when folks are responding to an emergency in the Brown County area or area they serve. Need input on this one especially.

- 2022 budget numbers reflected also include encumbrances, so will show lower balances.
- Received all authority for upgrade appropriated by Legislature.
