<u>APPROVE AGENDA</u>: Motion by Karpen, seconded by Greenfield, to add "Executive Session" to the meeting agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>APPROVE MINUTES FROM JULY 17, 2025, MEETING</u>: Motion by Ewing, seconded by Karpen, to approve the minutes from the July 17, 2025, Board of Minerals and Environment meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>MINING ISSUES CONSENT CALENDAR</u>: Prior to the meeting the board received a copy of the consent calendar (see attachment).

ANNUAL REVIEW OF OPEN MEETING LAWS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SDCL 1-25-13: Prior to the meeting the board members were provided with a copy of the brochure "Conducting the Public's Business in Public" revised in 2025 as published on the Attorney General's website https://atg.sd.gov/docs/July%202025OpenMeetingsLaw.pdf. The board was also provided with

copies of SB74 and HB1059.

HB1059 modified the definition of an official meeting to expand the definition to include electronic mail, instant messaging, social media, text messaging, or virtual meeting to the definition.

Board of Minerals and Environment September 17, 2025, Meeting Minutes

In SB74, a section was added to SDCL 1-11-1 to include that the Attorney General's Office would publish on its website an explanation of the open meeting laws each year before January 1. The bill also established that state agencies and public subdivisions, including boards and commissions, must annually review the published explanation and other information during an official meeting and include an acknowledgement that it completed this review in the official meeting minutes.

David McVey, Assistant Attorney General, explained the open meeting laws and answered questions.

Chairman Blumhardt acknowledged that the board had completed the annual review of the open meeting law.

Werner Pit Timeline

The landowner allowed mining activities at the site prior to the enactment of SDCL 45-6 in 1983. Prelaw operators did not preserve topsoil at the site, so the site had no topsoil when licensed mining activities commenced in 1992.

Timeline of Mining Licenses and Transfers:

03/24/1992 - Lyman County Highway Department received Mine License #215006.

04/15/1992 - Ed Byre & Sons (now Dana Byre) received Mine License #266001.

09/19/2007 – Ed Byre & Sons closed License #266001 and transferred reclamation liability to Lyman County Highway Department License #215006.

01/29/2008 - Christine Hamilton received Mine License #849001.

10/18/2018 – Lyman County Highway Department transferred its reclamation liability to the Oacoma Township Mine License #1033001.

Spring 2025 – Christine Hamilton and Oacoma Township hired a contractor to grade the pit and slope the highwalls.

07/08/2025 -

- Onsite inspection conducted at Christine Hamilton site #849001
- Onsite inspection conducted at Oacoma Township site #1033001

Reclamation Notes:

Vegetation was removed by pre-law operators and no topsoil was stockpiled for future reclamation. Due to this historical context, the department is not requiring the current operators to replace topsoil they never removed. However, all highwalls have been properly sloped and the pit floor has been graded, leaving the site in significantly better condition than when licensed mining began in 1992. A small stockpile of material remains onsite for the landowner's personal use.

DANR Final Inspection of Reclaimed Area

- Final inspection conducted August 20, 2025
- Final inspection results:
 - Required earthmoving, topsoil placement, and seeding completed in fall 2013
 - Area returned to rangeland for grazing
 - Release area exceeds 40 percent vegetative requirement and has self sustaining cover
 - No erosion or noxious weed infestations

Reclaimed Area Vegetative Cover

- Compared vegetative cover of reclaimed area to adjacent undisturbed reference area
- Average live vegetative cover results:
 - 52.4 percent in reclaimed areas
 - 49.6 percent in adjacent undisturbed reference area
 - Species in seed mix noted includes western, crested, and slender wheatgrasses and yellow sweetclover













Former Permit 29 Area

- Spotty vegetative cover in reclaimed 2.12 acre Small Scale Mine Permit 29 area
- A portion of Permit 29 area was planned to be redisturbed during mining under Large Scale Mine Permit 475
- Potential to improve vegetative cover in area
- Area not redisturbed, seeded with millet



Livestock Grazing Production

- ARSD 74:29:07:20(1)
 - Requires reclaimed affected land to support livestock carrying capacity similar to surrounding or reference area
- Baseline data showed pre-mine forage production of 0.25 animal unit months/acre
