
MEDICAID EXPANSION DEMOGRAPHICS

SOUTH DAKOTA MEDICAID TODAY: South Dakota Medicaid currently covers about 118,700 individuals in an average month. ¹

KEY FACTS


- Medicaid provides health care to 14% of all South Dakotans.
- The majority, 68% are children.
- Coverage for adults is limited to adults with a disability, very low income parents, and pregnant women.



MEDICAID EXPANSION POPULATION: South Dakota's expansion population is estimated at about 50,000 individuals.

KEY DEMOGRAPHICS

- 1/3 of the Expansion Population is parents with children with household incomes between 53%-138%
 Federal Poverty Level.
- 60% of the Expansion Population is working. Of those working, 2/3rds are working full time; 1/3rd is employed part time.



SOUTH DAKOTA MEDICAID AFTER

EXPANSION: Expansion adds adults with incomes up to 138% of the Federal Poverty Level to Medicaid.
