Topics include assistive technology, CIL core services, emergency preparedness, health and wellness, IL History and Philosophy, SILC Operations and SILC Roles and Responsibilities.

Other opportunities may arise for members to attend trainings/conferences hosted by various agencies i.e., Division of Rehabilitation Services, Service to the Blind and Visually Impaired, SD Housing and Development Authority, Center for Disabilities Symposium, and the SD Special Education Conference. Attendance at such events and conferences will be limited by the availability of funding.
