<u>12:68:15:12</u>	<u>Sale of retail meat products.</u>

12:68:15:12. Retail sale of meat products. Meat products may be produced by a licensed retail processor that maintains ownership of the products from production until purchase by the end consumer. For purposes of this section, products may be sold at the site of production or at a third-party location, provided that:

1. The production site and third-party site share common ownership, or
2. The licensed retail processor has a signed lease agreement with the third-party site giving the processor control over the place where the retail products are located., and
3. Temperature-sensitive products at the third-party location are maintained at or below 41 degrees F.
