

What's Next for JJRI Funded Services?

Improve Outcomes for Justice Involved Youth:

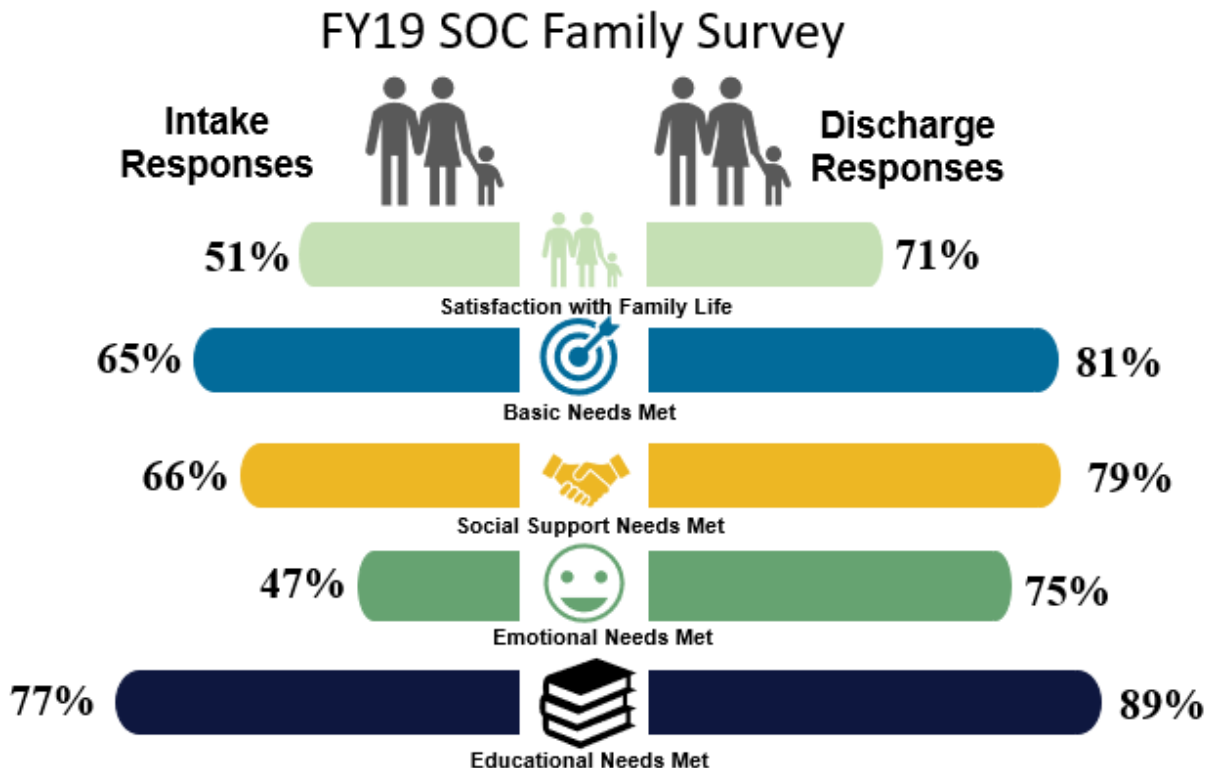
The Division continues to provide quality assurance for all evidence-based services and closely monitors outcomes, including successful completion rates. The Division maintains a minimum successful completion rate goal of 70% for all EBP services and will continue to offer training and technical assistance to assist providers to achieve this goal. In FY19, FFT services had a successful completion rate of 71%, ART services had a successful completion rate of 77%, and MRT services had a successful completion rate of 52%.

Intensive Family Services (IFS):

IFS is a collaborative project between the Division of Behavioral Health, Community Mental Health Centers (CMHCs) and Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facilities (PRTFs) to support youth to successfully transition from PRTF placements back into their home communities. The youth, family, PRTF, and CMHC will work together to develop a transition plan that both prepares the family for the youth's return home as well as reduces the youth's likelihood of returning to placement.

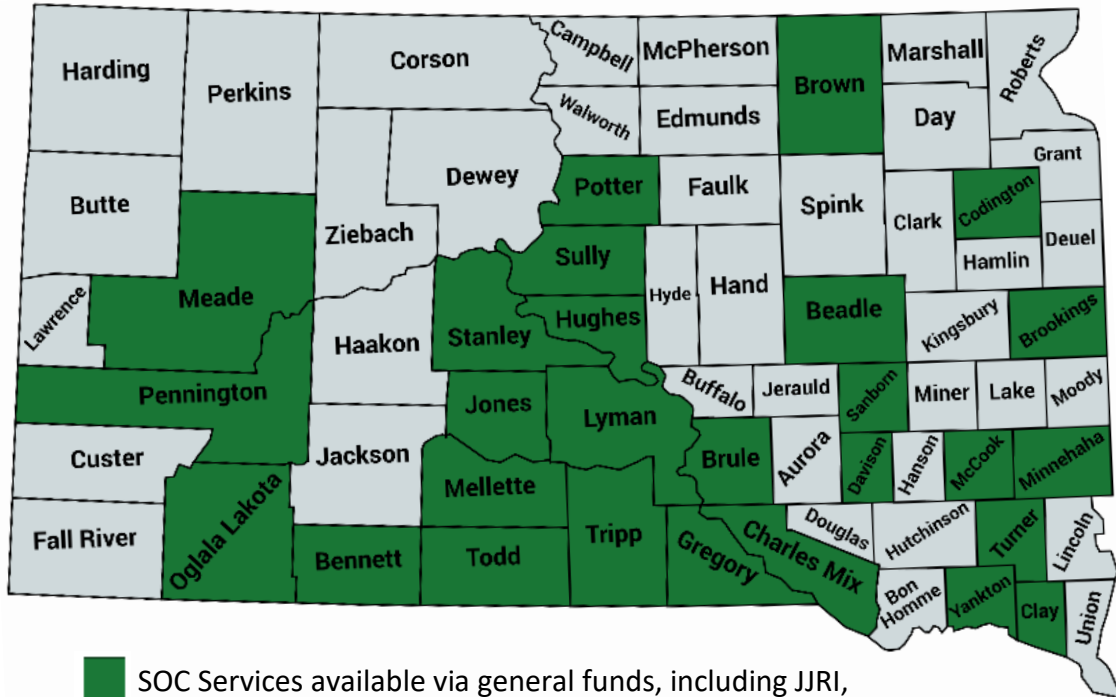
Systems of Care (SOC):

SOC services provide case management and other assistance to youth and families with a goal of reducing barriers that would otherwise put that youth at-risk of justice or other system involvement. In FY18, SOC services began with 5 care coordinator positions and have since grown to include 31 care coordinators throughout the state. The following graphic shows some of the benefits of SOC services, as reported by families who received SOC services.
