Call to Order/Welcome: Kornder called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m. CDT.

Roll Call: Kornder requested Tellinghuisen-Geddes call the roll. Kornder, yes; Willis, yes; Gangel, yes; Blue Arm, absent; Zandstra, absent; Brandt, yes. A quorum was present.

Corrections or additions to the agenda: None.

Approval of the agenda: Willis made a motion to approve the agenda. Gangle seconded the motion. **MOTION PASSED** by unanimous voice vote.

Public Comment: None.

Approval of the Minutes from Board meeting June 27, 2025: Brandt made a motion to approve the minutes from June 27, 2025. Willis seconded the motion. MOTION PASSED by unanimous voice vote.

FY Financial Update: Tellinghuisen-Geddes reported fiscal year-end figures as of June 30, 2025: expenses of \$128,477.52; revenue of \$202,836.24 and a cash balance of \$516,094.25.

ABA Updates: None.

Annual Review of Open Meeting Laws (SDCL 1-25-13): Tellinghuisen Geddes provided an overview of the guide to South Dakota's Open Meeting Laws, prepared by the Attorney General's Office as required by SDCL 1-25-13.

2025 Annual Meeting of the Delegate Assembly-November 7-8, 2025, Indianapolis, IN: Willis advised she will be in the same location the day prior for the Social Work Compact meeting and would be willing to represent the Board at this meeting as well. Gangle made a motion for the Board to fund Willis to attend the 2025 Annual Meeting of the Delegate Assembly. Blue Arm seconded the motion. MOTION PASSED by unanimous voice vote.

Election of Officers- Secretary Treasurer Only: It was reported that Bjork has resigned from the board and therefore the board should elect a new secretary/treasurer since that position was held by Bjork. Gangle volunteered to serve as Secretary/Treasurer. Willis made a motion to elect Gangle as Secretary/Treasurer. Brandt seconded the motion, MOTION PASSED by unanimous voice vote.

Social Work Licensure Compact-Background Check Updates: Willis advised the compact commission had a meeting last week and will be meeting again in Indianapolis, Indiana in November. For background check updates, Tellinghuisen Geddes advised that the board has run into issues obtaining their federal ORI number which will allow the board to facilitate background checks for the licensure compact. It was reported that the board will need to bring a bill to the 2026 legislative session to give the board authority to conduct background checks. Willis made a motion to bring legislation for the board to add legislative authority for background checks into statutes for multistate licenses. Gangle seconded the motion. MOTION PASSED by roll call vote. Kornder, yes; Willis, yes; Gangel, yes; Blue Arm, yes; Brandt, yes.

Schedule Next Meeting: The next meeting is scheduled for December 5, 2025, at 11 a.m. MST/12 p.m. CST via Microsoft Teams.

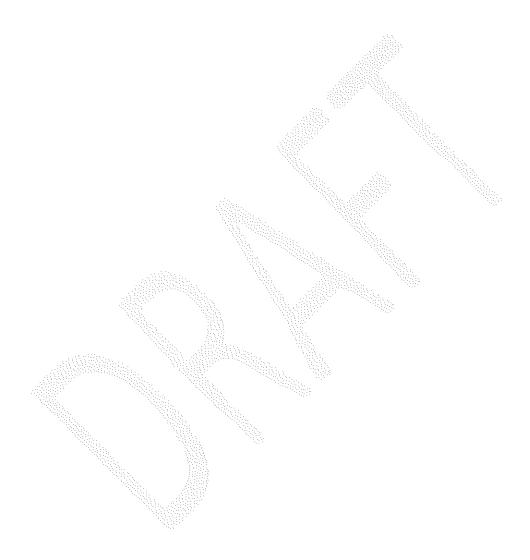

1-27-1.17. Draft minutes of public meeting to be available--Exceptions--Violation as misdemeanor. The unapproved, draft minutes of any public meeting held pursuant to § 1-25-1 that are required to be kept by law shall be available for inspection by any person within ten business days after the meeting. However, this section does not apply if an audio or video recording of the meeting is available to the public on the governing body's website within five business days after the meeting. A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor. However, the provisions of this section do not apply to draft minutes of contested case

General Authority: SDCL <u>36-26-29</u>. Law Implemented: SDCL <u>36-26-17</u>(2). <u>36-1D-1</u>. Eligibility--Licensure by endorsement.

Notwithstanding any existing provisions related to licensure by endorsement or licensure by reciprocity in any applicable licensing statute, a licensing board or a department secretary, if the secretary is responsible for issuing the license, shall issue a license, certificate, registration, or permit to an applicant to allow practice in this state if, upon application to the licensing board, the applicant satisfies all of the following conditions:

(1) Holds a current license, certificate, registration, or permit from another state, territory, or country and the licensing board determines that state's, territory's, or country's requirements are substantially

equivalent to or exceed the requirements established in this state;

(2) Demonstrates competency in the profession or occupation through methods determined by the licensing board or a department secretary, if the secretary is responsible for issuing the license;

(3) Has not committed any act that constitutes grounds for refusal, suspension, or revocation of a license, certificate, registration, or permit to practice that profession or occupation in this state unless the licensing board determines, in its discretion, that the act should not be an impediment to the granting of a license, certificate, registration, or permit to practice in this state;

(4) Is in good standing and has not been disciplined by the jurisdiction that issued the license, certificate, registration, or permit unless the licensing board determines, in its discretion, that the discipline should not be an impediment to the granting of a license, certificate, registration, or permit to practice

in this state; and

(5) Pays any fees established by the licensing board by rules promulgated pursuant to chapter <u>1-26</u>.
