Public Advisory Committee Meeting

This was a public meeting and other parties may have been in attendance.

The meeting was called to order at 11:04 AM. Roll was called, and quorum was established.

A motion for approval of the agenda was ratified (Binder/Luther/Unanimous).

A motion for approval of the minutes was approved. (Luther/Hermes/Unanimous).

The request for any public comment was made pursuant to SDCL 1-25-1. There was no public comment.

Committee charge and composition was discussed. The Board website Information for all SDBMOE Advisory Committees can be found by clicking on the dropdown menu under Board Info on the SDBMOE website. Advisory Committees page is being updated to include upcoming meetings. The South Dakota statutes and rules specific to the SDBMOE regulated professions can be found by clicking on the Laws tab.

A legislative update was discussed regarding the bills that will be enacted and new laws – specifically SDCL 36-4-4B - as of July 1, 2024. The term Committee will become Council and the composition will change. The committee members can make recommendations regarding individuals that they may recommend for the post 1 July composition changes. Criminal background investigation language also changes in the revised statute 36-4-4B. The required FBI approval of the criminal background investigations process has been requested. As of the date of this meeting; approval has not yet been received. Due to the new law, fingerprinting will revert to the two-step (split) process until FBI approval has been received. The committee members should make professional colleagues aware.

EMT-I/85 practice was discussed specifically regarding an inquiry as to whether I/85s can administer D50 via IV. The committee consensus was that I/85s and above can administer D50 and D10 via IV. The committee recommends the Board ratify an update to the practice document that D50 and D10 could be added to the EMT-I/85.

Community paramedic materials and information for the Advisory Committee were received the last week of May 2024. and have been provided for the Advisory Committee review. As subject matter experts, the Advisory Committee members input is required for writing rules. Community paramedic discussion continued, and this issue has been a subject of debate even prior to the SD Legislature authorizing community paramedics. Mention was made that community paramedical rules have been a standing committee agenda item since the law was enacted.

As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 11:46 AM

¹ 1-27-1.17. Draft minutes of public meeting to be available--Exceptions--Violation as misdemeanor. The unapproved, draft minutes of any public meeting held pursuant to § 1-25-1 that are required to be kept by law shall be available for inspection by any person within ten business days after the meeting. However, this section does not apply if an audio or video recording of the meeting is available to the public on the governing body's website within five business days after the meeting. A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor. However, the provisions of this section do not apply to draft minutes of contested case proceedings held in accordance with the provisions of chapter 1-26.
