**Public Advisory Committee Meeting**

This was a public meeting and other parties may have been in attendance.

The meeting was called to order at 12:01 PM. Roll was called, and quorum was established.

A motion for approval of the agenda was ratified (Baker/Herron/Unanimous).

A motion for approval of the minutes was approved. (Herron/Baker/Unanimous).

The request for any public comment was made pursuant to SDCL 1-25-1 and there was no public comment.

As SB 87 took effect July 1, the council, formerly committee, charge was discussed. Updates based upon the legislation was discussed including communication between the RCP Advisory Council and the BMOE will be more formalized to create a good flow of communication.

The council was given a refresher on the importance of adhering to the open meetings requirements. All advisory council meetings must meet these requirements, ensuring transparency and accountability.

A practice inquiry discussion regarding Extracorporeal Membrane Oxygenation (ECMO) and IV fluids took place. The council agreed that ECMO was within an RCPs practice, given the training meets the American Association for Respiratory Care (AARC) expectations. The council also agreed that RCPs placing and maintaining IVs should be up to the healthcare facility, recognizing that each facility has its own protocols.

As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 12:32 PM

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<sup>1</sup> 1-27-1.17. Draft minutes of public meeting to be available--Exceptions--Violation as misdemeanor. The unapproved, draft minutes of any public meeting held pursuant to § 1-25-1 that are required to be kept by law shall be available for inspection by any person within ten business days after the meeting. However, this section does not apply if an audio or video recording of the meeting is available to the public on the governing body's website within five business days after the meeting. A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor. However, the provisions of this section do not apply to draft minutes of contested case proceedings held in accordance with the provisions of chapter 1-26.
