## Financial Report – Fiscal Year 2026 (Jan-March)

Prepared for Board Members

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### Overview

From January through March 2026, the Board recorded **\$109,125.00** in total revenue and **\$175,837.14** in total expenditures, resulting in a **net deficit of \$66,712.14** for the three-month period. The deficit is driven primarily by the planned **\$80,000.00 capital outlay** in March for software.

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### Revenue Highlights (Jan–Mar 2026)

  - **Other Engineering Fees: \$15.00 (~0.01%)**

### Expenditure Summary (Jan–Mar 2026)

Total Expenditures: **\$175,837.14**

- **Salaries & Wages (Full-Time Employees): \$48,106.60 (~27.36%)**
  - **Board Member Fees: \$6,308.00 (~3.59%)**
  - **Benefits (Health/Life, OASI, Retirement, UI, WC): \$16,795.72 (~9.55%)**
  - **Travel: \$224.00 (~0.13%)**
  - **Contractual Services: \$19,605.88 (~11.15%)**
  - **Supplies & Materials: \$855.84 (~0.49%)**
  - **Capital Outlay (Software): \$80,000.00 (~45.50%)**
  - **Indirect Costs: \$3,941.10 (~2.24%)**
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### Conclusion & Outlook

Revenues for the period were driven primarily by certification renewals, which accounted for nearly 70 percent of total receipts. The overall deficit for January through March reflects the planned one-time software purchase in March. With this major capital outlay completed, the Board is positioned for more normalized financial activity for the remainder of the fiscal year. Ongoing monitoring of revenue trends and expenditure categories will support continued fiscal planning and long-term sustainability.
