Meeting Minutes SOUTH DAKOTA COSMETOLOGY COMMISSION

President Crystal Carlson called the meeting to order at 8:30 am.

Secretary-Treasurer Tami Stokes read the roll and a quorum was established.

Executive Director Kate Boyd withdrew the four petitions for declaratory ruling and noted they will be resubmitted for the April meeting. Debbie Pageler made a motion to approve the agenda as amended. Tami Stokes seconded the motion. **MOTION PASSED**.

Crystal Carlson made a motion to approve the minutes of the December 6, 2019 meeting. Annette Petersen seconded the motion. **MOTION PASSED**.

Treasurer Tami Stokes stated the available funds balance is \$183,731.30 and the cash center balance is \$116,201.52. Executive Director Kate Boyd noted that the fee increases went into effect 1/1/20, so we should start seeing the cash center balance increasing.

The Executive Director's Report was included in the meeting handouts and included the following information: (1) Legislative Update of three bills that affect the Commission or our licensees; (2) School name change from Headlines Academy to Paul Mitchell The School Rapid City; (3) Black Hills Beauty College is being sold effective March 1, 2020 and there will be a new name, The Salon Professional Academy (TSPA); (4) Information for Commission members on the two NIC meetings being held in 2020; and (5) report of lapsed license disciplinary action fees. A copy of the Executive Director's Report is attached to these minutes.

Executive Director Boyd informed the Commission that NIC is in the process of developing written practical examinations for all the license types we currently test using the NIC hands-on practical examination. The new written practical exams will be rolled out July 1, 2020. The exams questions will give a scenario and the applicant must choose the correct answer. It is our understanding that there will be a Candidate Information Bulletin for this exam, as there is for the hands-on practical and the theory exam. Our commission could choose to discontinue use of the current hands-on practical exam and start using the written practical when it becomes available. She said that she is researching computer-based test options in Sioux Falls, Watertown and Rapid City so that candidates will not be required to come to Pierre for any of the exams.

Crystal Carlson made a motion to discontinue use of the current NIC hands-on practical examination and begin using the NIC written practical examination when it becomes available July 1, 2020. Renee Graff seconded the motion. **MOTION PASSED.** (Carlson yea; Graf yea; Pageler yea; Petersen yea; Stokes abstain).

The Commission reviewed the draft inspection reports several additions and clarifications were made. Tami Stokes made a motion to adopt the new salon/booth and school/student clinic floor inspection reports with the changes noted. Renee Graf seconded the motion. **MOTION PASSED.**

Annette Petersen made a motion to approve the school license renewal application for Black Hills Beauty College. Debbie Pageler seconded the motion. **MOTION PASSED.**

Annette Petersen made a motion to approve the new school application for The Salon Professional Academy, formerly Black Hills Beauty College. Debbie Pageler seconded the motion. **MOTION PASSED.**

Renee Graf made a motion to approve the apprentice application of Bradi Heinz at Revive Day Spa in Aberdeen. Tami Stokes seconded the motion. **MOTION PASSED.**

Debbie Pageler made a motion to approve the eyelash extension education provider application of Chantelle Duncan. **MOTION PASSED.**

Tami Stokes made a motion to approve the student license application from the individual with felony convictions. **MOTION PASSED**.

The upcoming meetings and exam dates were reviewed. The Commission requested that the Watertown and Sioux Falls school visits and Commission meeting be rearranged to begin in Sioux Falls on Thursday afternoon and then drive to Watertown for the school visit and

Commission meeting Friday morning. Further it was agreed to change the July 24 Commission meeting date to mid-June. Friday, June 19 was suggested as a possibility. Members will check their personal calendars and confirm if they are available that day.

Out-of-State Travel Requests were handed out to the Commission for their use if they want to request to attend the April 24-26, 2020 NIC all Region Meeting in Biloxi, Mississippi or October 2-5, 2020 NIC Annual Conference in Lexington, Kentucky. It was noted that all out-of-state travel requests must be approved by the Department of Labor & Regulation Secretary. Two to three members are normally approved to attend each meeting, together with the Executive Director.

Crystal Carlson made a motion to adjourn. Debbie Pageler seconded the motion. **MOTION PASSED**.

SOUTH DAKOTA COSMETOLOGY COMMISSION EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

January 24, 2020

- 1. Legislative Update As of January 14, 2020, there are three legislative bills being introduced in the Legislative Session of interest to the Commission. Copies of these bills are included in the meeting packets and are briefly summarized below.
 - **SB 10** will allow the Cosmetology Commission to allow credit for general coursework completed in other programs or institutions, not specific to cosmetology, nail technology, or esthetics, to be applied to any course of study required for licensure with the Commission. The bill authorizes the Commission to establish criteria for accepting and applying the allowable credit.

Individuals who may be interested in this cross-over education for licensing with the Commission may include licensed massage therapists, makeup artists, barbers, or medical personnel.

- **SB 13** is similar to SB 10, in that is allows the South Dakota Board of Barber Examiners to allow credit for general coursework completed in other programs or institutions, not specific to barbering, to be applied to any course of study required for certification with the Barber Board. The bill authorizes the Board to establish criteria for accepting and applying the allowable credit. A cosmetologist could attend a South Dakota school of barbering for the required hours and curriculum set by the Board of Barber Examiners to apply for a SD barber certificate.
- SB 23 will remove the high school education requirement to be licensed with the Cosmetology Commission. It does not change the minimum age of 17 to attend cosmetology school or minimum age of 18 to become fully licensed with the Commission.
- 2. School Name Change -- Peggy Sproat, owner of Headlines Academy, has informed the Commission that her school has become a Paul Mitchell School. The official school name is Paul Mitchell The School Rapid City. A school name change does not require a new school license.
- 3. Sale of School Black Hills Beauty College (BHBC) is being purchased by Wendy Beaumont, effective March 1, 2020 and will have a new name, The Salon Professional Academy (T-SPA). The current license for Black Hills Beauty College expires February 1, 2020; therefore, the Commission meeting packets include a school license renewal application from BHBC and new school license application from T-SPA.
- 4. 2020 NIC All Region Meeting and Annual Conference Enclosed is a copy of the 2020 Meeting and Exam Calendar. Of special note are the two NIC Meetings being held in April in Biloxi, Mississippi and in October in Louisville, Kentucky. Out-of-state travel request forms will be available at the January 24 Commission meeting for any Commission member who wants to request approval to attend either of these meetings.
- 5. Lapsed License Disciplinary Action Fees The Commission had asked the Violations Committee to revisit the fees that are proposed in consent agreements in lieu of license suspension. The fees begin at \$50 for a license lapsed two months, and an additional \$25 is added on for each additional month the license was lapsed. If the licensee has two lapsed licenses personal license and salon/booth, we have only been imposing the fee for the license that has been lapsed the longest. In accordance with Commission direction at the September 20 Commission meeting, the Violations Committee recommends that the fee structure remain the same, but that if two licenses are lapsed, the fee for the license that has been lapsed the longest will be offered, together with 25% of what the monthly fee for the second license would be.

SOUTH DAKOTA COSMETOLOGY COMMISSION EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

April 17, 2020

1. Changes Due to Coronavirus Pandemic

- NIC cancelled the Spring Symposium scheduled for April 24-26, 2020 in Biloxi, Mississippi.
- State Board Exam testing has been suspended. We cancelled the exams scheduled for March 16 & 17, 2020 and are not certain if we will be able to proceed with the May 17 & 18 exams.
- On March 13, 2020, the Governor issued an Executive Order for all non-essential state employees to work remotely. State offices will remain closed to the public until at least May 2, 2020. The Commission staff continues to perform our duties.
- The past three weeks have been filled with and unimaginable number of phone calls and emails from our licensees wondering if the Commission or the State will order the closure of salons, spas, and barber shops. The Commission does not have the authority to take such action and currently it does not appear that the Governor is planning to issue a mandated closure order. It remains up to the individual business owner whether or not to close their business.
- Many of the callers and email messages have been from individuals who are very
 upset by the Commission's inaction. We have tried to overlook or calm their anger as
 we realize the basis is likely fear for their health and the health of their family and
 clients, and fear for how they can meet their financial obligations with reduced or no
 earnings.
- The CARES stimulus law passed by Congress on March 31 includes financial provisions for independent contractors and business owners. The details are still being worked out of how to file for financial assistance.

2. Declaratory Rulings

Due to the additional time being spent by our staff responding to individuals about the possibility of salon closure, and with the cancellation of the April 16 & 17 schools visits and in-person Commission meeting, we will not be presenting declaratory rulings for the Commission's consideration on April 17, 2020.

3. Administrative Rules for Cross-over Licensing

To date there has been no work done to create requirements for cross-over licensing. All of us, staff and Commission members, have been preoccupied with the current health pandemic. We are not under any time restraints to develop rules for cross-over licensing.

Our classes start in April, June, September, November and February. Students have basic training for ten weeks (166 hours of theory training). After a student graduates from basics they have Advance Training for seven hours one day each week until they graduate (theory averages three hours and the remaining time is hands-on/practical training). We hold advance training by class start date. Advance training classes are scheduled Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.

Esthetics:

We hold an Esthetics course three times a year, January, April and July. They have four weeks of basics training (120 hours) which consists of 55 – 60% theory and the remaining is hands-on/practical training. After the completion of basics, they have Advance Training one day (seven hours) each week until they graduate with 3.5 hours of theory and 3.5 hours hands-on/practical training. Their Advance Training is held on Fridays.

Nail Technology:

We hold a Nail Technology course one time a year in January. They have two weeks of basic training (80 hours), which consists of about 45-50% theory, and the remaining is hands on practice. After the completion of basics, they have Advance Training one day (seven hours) each week until they graduate consisting of three hours of theory and the remaining time hands-on/practical training. Their Advance Training would be held on Wednesdays.

Esthetics: After the completion of the first four weeks of basic training the students have 29 hours of clinical training each week.

Nail Technology: After the completion of the first two weeks of basic training the students have 29 hours of clinical training each week.

In consideration of the above matter and in lieu of issuance of a notice of hearing and formal hearing, the undersigned parties do hereby consent and agree to the following:

- Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen, whose address is 2701 W. 41st St., Suite F, Sioux Falls,
 SD 57105, is licensed as a nail technician with the South Dakota Cosmetology
 Commission (Commission). Her license number is NT-06721-2013.
- Nails, whose address is 2701 W. 41st St., Suite F, Sioux Falls, SD 57105, is a licensed salon with the Commission. Its license number is NS-03130-2014 and its owner of record is Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen.
- 3. On or about March 26, 2013, 1 Nails and Ms. Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen allowed an unlicensed individual to perform nail technician services on its premises. An individual is required by law to be duly licensed in South Dakota to legally perform the nail technician services that the individual was performing.
- 4. When the Commission's inspector went to her car to write up her report about the incident, Ms. Nguyen met the inspector at her car and requested that the incident

not be reported to the Commission and handed her a \$100 and some gift cards.

The inspector declined to accept the money and stated that the incident would be reported to the Commission.

- The above described conduct constitutes grounds for disciplinary action in South
 Dakota against Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen and 1 Nails.
- 6. Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen and 1 Nails are aware of and understand the nature of these matters and have been informed of their right to counsel, notice, hearing, and appeal, and that by agreeing to and signing this Consent Agreement, they waive all procedures and proceedings before the Commission to which they may be entitled under state or federal law.
- 7. Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen and 1 Nails admit that the violations described in this

 Consent Agreement are true and accurate, and both Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen and 1

 Nails admit to having violated South Dakota Law and Administrative Rules of

 South Dakota.
- 8. In return for Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen and 1 Nails' agreement to the provisions of this Consent Agreement, the Commission agrees not to proceed to hearing and agrees that this Consent Agreement will constitute the final agency disposition of this matter.
- 9. Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen and 1 Nails agree, in lieu of contesting this matter formally, to voluntarily accept the following terms and conditions for entry of this Consent Agreement:

- Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen's personal license, #NT-06721-2013, will be suspended for a period of 40 days with 26 days being held in abeyance.
 Ms. Nguyen's license will be actively suspended for 14 days from September 8, 2013, through September 21, 2013;
- b. 1 Nails' license, #NS-03130-2014, will be suspended for the same period of time and with similar conditions as the suspension of Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen's personal license, the suspension running concurrent with Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen's suspension;
- c. The remaining 26 days of suspension for both licenses will be held in abeyance for a period of 1 year, beginning on the effective date of this agreement, so long as the following conditions are met:
 - Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen and 1 Nails will comply with all laws and regulations relating to their profession under SDCL chapter 36-15 and ARSD article 20:42 for a period of 1 year beginning on the effective date of this Agreement;
 - 2) Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen will successfully pay for and successfully complete the Commission's State Laws course by successfully passing the post-course exam within 2 months of the execution of this Agreement. The cost of the course and exam is \$50.00; and
 - 3) 1 Nails will be subject to additional inspections for a period of one year from the date of execution of this Agreement. Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen will make a onetime payment to the Commission for the

additional expenses of the inspections in the amount of \$350.00 within 2 months of the execution of this Agreement;

- 10. If Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen or 1 Nails fail to comply with the terms or conditions of this Consent Agreement, the Commission may initiate formal disciplinary action against the breeching party;

An administrative hearing was held on April 22, 2014, before the Office of Hearing Examiners and the South Dakota State Cosmetology Commission in Pierre, South Dakota. Hearing Examiner Ryan Darling was present and presided over the hearing. The following Cosmetology Commission members were present: Ms. Lois Porch, Ms. Nora Slykhuis, Ms. Lori Little, Ms. Lori Berreth and Ms. Tammy Ugofsky. Ms. Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen, Respondent, did personally appear and testify on behalf of both Respondents. The Cosmetology Commission was represented by attorney Mr. Aaron N. Arnold. The witnesses that was present and presented testimony on behalf of the Commission: Ms. Kate Boyd, Executive Director of the Commission, and Ms. Noreen Johnson, an inspector for the Commission.

Upon receiving the evidence and hearing the testimony presented, Hearing Examiner Darling issued a Proposed Decision, which included Findings of Fact, Reasoning, Conclusions of Law and a Proposed Order, on June 25, 2014. On August 5, 2014, the Cosmetology Commission met to take action in this case. After review of Hearing Examiner Darling's Proposed Decision and a unanimous vote by the Cosmetology Commission, it is hereby

ORDERED that Findings of Fact, Reasoning and Conclusions of Law issued by Hearing Examiner Darling on June 25, 2014, attached hereto and fully incorporated herein, are adopted in all respects;

ORDERED that Proposed Order issued by Hearing Examiner Darling on June 25, 2015, is attached hereto, is fully incorporated herein, and is fully adopted in all respects except as modified by this Order;

ORDERED that 1 Nails' license, License No. NS-03130, is hereby permanently revoked, beginning on the effective date of this Order;

ORDERED that, pursuant to SDCL 1-26-29.1, 1 Nails shall reimburse the Commission for its costs for the administrative hearing in the amount of \$1,283.51 joint and several with Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen by July 31, 2015. The costs are as follows:

- a. Court reporting services for the hearing, including transcript costs: \$242.75;
- b. Commission travel expenses and honorarium pay: \$1,040.76;

ORDERED that Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen's license, License No. NT-06721, is hereby permanently revoked, beginning on the effective date of this Order; and

ORDERED that, pursuant to SDCL 1-26-29.1, Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen shall reimburse the Commission for its costs for the administrative hearing in the amount of \$1,283.51 joint and several with 1 Nails by July 31, 2015. The costs are as follows:

- a. Court reporting services for the hearing, including transcript costs: \$242.75; and
- b. Commission travel expenses and honorarium pay: \$1,040.76.

NOTICE: This is the final decision of the South Dakota Department of Labor and Regulation, State Cosmetology Commission. PROPOSED DECISION COS 14-01

An administrative hearing was held in this matter on April 22, 2014. Petitioner, Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen [sometimes hereinafter Nguyen] appeared and testified at the hearing. The Cosmetology Commission, [sometimes hereinafter Commission] was represented by Aaron Arnold. The Commission members present were Kate Boyd, Lois Porch (President), Nora Slykhuis (Vice-president), Lori Little, Lori Berreth, and Tammy Ugofsky. Based on the evidence, the arguments of the parties, and the law, the Hearing Examiner enters the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Proposed Order.

ISSUES

Whether Nguyen violated state laws or administrative rules which resulted in the Commission taking disciplinary action against Nguyen and #1 Nails?

FINDINGS OF FACT

1.

The Salon called #1 Nails is located at 2701 West 41st Street, Suite F, Sioux Falls, South Dakota. The Salon is licensed by the Commission and the number is NS-03130.

11.

#1 Nails is owned and operated by Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen. Nguyen is a licensed nail technician with the Commission. Her license number is NT-06721

111.

The Commission has inspectors that visit salons to see if they are complying with state rules and regulations. Areas of inspection include cleanliness and safety.

IV.

In March of 2013, there was a routine inspection of #1 Nails and it was discovered that one of the workers did not have the proper Cosmetology License.

V.

After the inspection, Nguyen attempted to give the inspector an envelope that contained \$100 and a gift certificate to Applebees Restaurant. The inspector gave the envelope back and told Nguyen that she cannot accept gifts.

Nguyen requested that the incident not be reported.

VII.

The inspector filed a report with the Commission. As a result of using an unlicensed worker, Nguyen had to pay a penalty and the salon was shut down for two weeks in September 2013.

VIII.

Nguyen also had to take a safety and sanitation course as a result of the violation. The course covered cleaning and disinfecting everything in a nail salon, including pedicure chairs.

IX.

The same inspector visited #1 Nails on January 29, 2014, to do a follow up inspection. The Salon was dirty. There were bottles of Barbicide covered with crud. The jet covers for the pedicure chairs were very dirty, even though they are supposed to be cleaned daily. The buffers were well used and should have been thrown away. A Cleaning utensil and tray were also dirty.

Χ.

As the inspector explained that the salon failed the inspection and what needed to be done, Nguyen tried to give the inspector a "Christmas gift". Nguyen attempted to put an envelope with five \$100 dollar bills into the inspector's bag. The inspector refused the envelope and gave it back.

XI.

Following the January 29, 2013 incident, the inspector filed a complaint with the Commission.

XII.

On January 26, 2014, Nguyen sent a letter to the Commission apologizing for trying to give money to an inspector. She alleged that it was a Vietnamese New Year gift.

XIII.

A hearing on the matter was held on April 22, 2014.

XIV.

Any additional findings included in the Reasoning section of this decision are incorporated herein by this reference. To the extent any of the foregoing are improperly designated and are instead conclusions of law, they are hereby redesignated and incorporated herein as conclusions of law.

REASONING

The proceedings for cancellation, revocation, or suspension of a license may be initiated when the cosmetology commission has information that any person may have been guilty of any misconduct as provided in § 36-15-56, or is guilty of incompetence, negligence, or unprofessional or dishonorable conduct. SDCL 36-15-58

In this case, Nguyen tried to give the inspector an envelope containing money during an inspection. During the first incident, she tried to give the inspector money and a gift certificate. The inspector made it very clear that she was not allowed to accept gifts. Less than a year later, Nguyen tried to give the same inspector an envelope containing five hundred dollars during an inspection. This is unprofessional or dishonorable conduct. Nguyen was told that inspectors cannot accept gifts, yet she attempted to do it again.

This hearing examiner finds that the Cosmetology Commission has established by a preponderance of the evidence that Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen has committed the violations set forth in the complaint. The Cosmetology Commission should discipline Ngoc Lan Thi Nguyen as the law allows and as Cosmetology Commission deems appropriate based upon their experience and practices and knowledge of others similarly situated.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1.

The Department of Labor and Regulation has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter of this appeal. The Office of Hearing Examiners has authority to conduct the appeal pursuant to the provisions of 1-26D.

11.

The Cosmetology Commission has shown that Nguyen was involved in unprofessional or dishonorable conduct. SDCL 36-15-58

111.

Any Conclusions of Law in the reasoning section of this decision are incorporated herein by reference. To the extent any of the foregoing are improperly designated and are instead findings of fact, they are hereby redesignated and incorporated herein as findings of fact.

PROPOSED ORDER

It is the Proposed Order of the Hearing Examiner that #1 Nails be subject to such sanction as the law allows and the Commission in its discretion and experience may deem appropriate.

An administrative hearing was held on April 22, 2014 before the Office of Hearing Examiners and the South Dakota State Cosmetology Commission in Pierre, South Dakota. Upon receiving the evidence and hearing the testimony presented, Hearing Examiner Ryan Darling issued a Proposed Decision, which included Findings of Fact, Reasoning, Conclusions of Law and a Proposed Order, on June 25, 2014. On August 5, 2014, the Cosmetology Commission met to take action in this case. After review of Hearing Examiner Darling's Proposed Decision and a unanimous vote by the Cosmetology Commission, the Commission issued an Order which permanently revoked Ms. Nguyen's license.

The Commission met on September 25, 2015, at its regularly scheduled meeting in Sioux Falls, South Dakota. Ms. Nguyen and her boyfriend attended the meeting and requested that the Commission reconsider its revocation of her license. The only testimony presented by Ms. Nguyen or her witness addressed how Ms. Nguyen wanted to work again and how she missed her clients. No evidence was presented that Ms. Nguyen can or will comply with the licensure laws and rules of the Commission. In addition, Ms. Nguyen submitted an application for reconsideration, but it was not received prior to the Commission meeting. On said application, Ms. Nguyen failed to complete the portion of the application which asks Ms. Nguyen how she could assure the Commission that she would comply with the licensure laws of the Commission.

Due to the lack of any evidence that would ensure to the Commission that Ms. Nguyen will comply with the licensure laws of the Commission and by a unanimous vote by the Cosmetology Commission, it is hereby

ORDERED that the permanent revocation of Ms. Nguyen, as ordered by the Commission on August 5, 2014, shall remain in effect and that Ms. Nguyen may not request a reconsideration of the revocation of her license for a minimum period of time of five years.

As you know, there was a complaint filed against you and your salon for allowing an unlicensed individual to perform services. As well as operating a salon in unsanitary conditions and attempting to bribe a South Dakota State Inspector. I have enclosed a copy of the signed executed consent agreements. They are Case C- 2013 and Case C- 2014.

Per our phone conversation you have given permission to have us speak with your family member Aivi on your behalf. As discussed with her she expressed your desire to have your Nail Technology license that was permanently revoked reinstated.

In review of your previous cases it was discovered that payment of your penalties has not been received. This matter needs to be taken care of before the commission can consider a request for reinstatement. It appears that you owe a \$300.000 penalty for your offence as noted in a noted in 9 C-3 of the signed consent agreement Case C -2013.

In review of Case C 2014, you owed a \$1283,51 for reimbursement to the Cosmetology Commission for Administrative Hearing costs incurred. This is noted on page 2 of the Hearing Order. This bring the total owed to the Cosmetology Commission to \$1583.51. Please remit a check or money order for this amount. For your convenience I have enclosed a return envelope.

After the fees have been paid you may send a letter of request to our office concerning your desire to have your Nail Technology license reinstated. After we receive your request letter, it will be presented to the Cosmetology Commission at their next meeting for consideration. You will be notified of their response by mail. I will also include a breakdown of reinstatement fees you will owe should their decision be favorable to your request.
