The effects of the rules will be to add the executive secretary to supervise administrative duties of the board, define chain of title, update language for meetings/special meetings of the Board, repeal unanimous consent meetings, repeal outdated language on orders and decisions of the Board, add a clause to eligibility for military personnel, update language to require notarized signature for applicants, provide additional locations and designated representatives for examinations, revise the timeline for grading examinations, update language for general requirements for books, records, and indexes, update language relating to grading of plant examinations, update language regarding fees and expenses for plant examinations and language for issuance of certificate for plant.

Written comments and testimony must relate directly to the changes being proposed and must cite the specific rule number to which the comments are being directed.
